DISCONTINUANCE OF RAILROAD-BUS COUPONS

EXTENSION OF 10¢ SHUTTLE SERVICE IN LOOP

To All Concerned:-

Effective February 1st, Railroad Commuter Bus Coupons will be discontinued.

These coupons should not be accepted by Operators after January 31st. If presented, Operator should advise passenger that coupons have been discontinued and collect fare. Passengers may return any unused coupons to the Railroads for refund.

Effective same date, 10¢ shuttle service in the Loop will be extended on ROUTES 148 & 149 furnishing all day service -- and ROUTES 142, 158 & 128 furnishing A.M. & P.M. Rush Hour service, Weekdays only.

TRANSFERS WILL BE ISSUED from these 10¢ line to other CTA lines only upon payment of regular fare (Token or 20¢) for adults.

Child-student rates will apply as usual; these riders will be entitled to free transfers to other CTA lines.

TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED from other CTA lines at regular transfer points.

Copy of attached pamphlet giving details of the new Downtown Shopper-Depot-Parking Lot 10¢ shuttle service, will be given to all drivers, and distributed to the public.
