Mr. O'Connor:-

On March 31st I sent thru memorandum to the effect that for the period Oct. 1, 1952 to March 28, 1953 the Boulevard System lost 167 operators -- compared with loss of 63 operators for same period of 1951-52.

Since that time, the loss of Operators on the Boulevard System has taken a tremendous increase -- and not one new man hired for replacement these past few weeks.
