TO ALL BOULEVARD SYSTEM OPERATORS:

OPERATION AT RAILROAD GRADE CROSSINGS
RIVER BRIDGES

When a bus approaches a railroad grade crossing the operator will bring the bus to a full stop at a point not less than 25 feet from the nearest rail of the track.

All buses must be brought to a full and complete stop before crossing river bridges.

So much danger is involved in careless operation at railroad grade crossings and bridges that any violation of rules must be followed by disciplinary action.
