# REGULATIONS FOR YARD FOREMEN AND SWITCHMEN GOVERNING OPERATION OF TEST TRAINS IN RAPID TRANSIT YARDS

As per bulletin G 6-71, the following regulations are in effect for operation of test trains in all rapid transit yards.

- 1. The Yard Foreman has final approval on the operation of any test in the yard requiring train movement of more than five feet except those which Shops and Equipment personnel are authorized to make. (See 'Regulations Governing Testing of Rapid Transit Trains by Shops and Equipment Personnel.') The Yard Foreman is responsible for the safe operation of all trains in the yard and must take into account such factors as rail condition, visibility and potential interference with normal yard operation before granting permission to a Switchman to operate a test train.
- 2. When a request is made by the Terminal Foreman or person in charge in the foreman's absence, the Yard Foreman <u>must</u> provide a Switchman to operate the train <u>as soon as</u> he is satisfied it is safe to do so and <u>as soon as</u> manpower is available without adversely affecting normal yard operations.
- Test trains may be operated only on the yard track designated for that purpose. (See reverse side for list of designated test tracks.)
- Test trains may not exceed 15 M.P.H. and may not be operated beyond the clearance point of the designated track.

Whenever a test will require a higher speed than is hereby permitted in the yard or a greater distance of operation than is available on the designated test track, the Yard Foreman must contact the District Superintendent to obtain permission to operate the test train at a different location.

Under no circumstances is the Yard Foreman permitted to authorize a test on any track other than the designated track or at a speed in excess of 15 M.P.H.

 The track designated for test purposes will be kept clear of storage trains until all other yard tracks are filled to capacity.

#### NORTH SECTION

Howard - Track 7 S
Kimball - Track 15 †
Linden - North Lead † †
Skokie - Track 21
Wilson - Track 10

#### SOUTH SECTION

Ashland - Track 3E 61st Street - Track 9A 95th Street - Track 1

#### WEST SECTION

- † When using Track 15 (Kimball Yard) for test train operation, the Yard Foreman must be certain that a portable stop sign is placed on the crosswalk.
- † † When using the North Lead (Linden Yard) for test train operation, the Yard Foreman must be certain that a portable stop sign is placed in the center of the track at the south end of the North Lead.
- † † † When using Track 1W (Jefferson Park) for test train operation, the Yard Foreman must be certain that a portable stop sign is placed in the center of the track at the east end of Track 1W.
