

EMPLOYEE'S GUIDE TO THE POWER OPERATED SWITCHES AT 95TH

Effective immediately, the procedures for the power operated switches controlling moves from the pull back tracks into the north and southbound pockets are as follows:

MOVES TO NORTHBOUND POCKET

Button can be depressed from the motorman's cab at either of the two power operated switches and will line the switch for moves into the northbound pocket.

MOVES TO SOUTHBOUND POCKET

For moves against traffic into the southbound pocket:

1. Insert switch key into the lock near the bottom of the pole.
2. Open the box and depress the button.
3. After the switch is lined up for the move into the southbound pocket, release the button.
4. Close and lock the box.
5. Proceed with caution into the southbound pocket.

Press this button if you wish to line switch for move into Northbound Pocket.

For moves against traffic into the Southbound Pocket:

1. Insert switch key into the lock near the bottom of the pole.
2. Open the box and depress the button.
3. After the switch is lined up for the move into the southbound pocket, release the button.
4. Close and lock the box.
5. Proceed with caution into the southbound pocket.

MOVES TO SOUTHBOUND POCKET

- For moves against traffic into the southbound pocket:
1. Insert switch key into the lock near the bottom of the pole.
 2. Open the box and depress the button.
 3. After the switch is lined up for the move into the southbound pocket, release the button.
 4. Close and lock the box.
 5. Proceed with caution into the southbound pocket.
