SUBJECT: Inauguration of Skokie Swift Service

EFFECTIVE: Monday, April 20, 1964

Effective the above date, Rapid Transit service between Dempster Street, Skokie and Howard Street, Chicago, will be inaugurated. Passenger stops will be made only at these two stations.

Single car trains, operated by Rapid Transit Operators, will operate at 10 minute intervals in rush hours and at 30 minute intervals at other times. Service will be operated from approximately 6:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. There will be no service Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays.

The fare, including transfer privileges, will be 45¢ for adults, 29¢ for children and students with Identification Card, and 20¢ for C.T.A. employes not in full uniform presenting the Chicago Transit Authority Riding Pass or Badge. Children under 7 years of age accompanied by passenger paying an adult fare, and Dempster Street Agents going on duty or coming off duty are permitted to ride free of charge.

An Agent will be on duty at Dempster Station during rush hours. During the hours the Agent is not on duty, passengers will deposit fares in the fare box at the Operator's position on the train.

Fare differentials paid by Northbound passengers will be collected and registered by the Agents on the Northbound Howard platform.

Valid transfers presented for a ride must be lifted by the Dempster Street Agent and by the Operator. These lifted transfers must be placed in the "Lifted Transfers" envelope (CTA 3040) and turned in to the Receiver.

The Receiver will forward to the Revenue Accounting Department, in one bag, all Skokie "Summary of Transfers" envelopes, "Lifted Transfers" envelopes, Trip Sheets and Agent's Reports.

Operating and fare collection procedures are outlined in the pamphlet "Employes Guide to Skokie Swift Service", T & A P 64-2-C3.
