TO: All Concerned, Rail

SUBJECT: New Signal at Forest Park Terminal, West-South Route

EFFECTIVE: Tuesday, May 13, 1980 - 1000 Hours

On the above date and time, signal LK1-468 will be placed in service on the northbound/westbound track west of Harlem Station, West-South Route.

Trains must approach the time-controlled signal and stop to allow the signal to clear before proceeding.

When the designated turn-back track is being used, the signal will clear automatically so that the train can be safely operated onto Track #1.

When the designated turn-back track is not being used. All train movements will be under the jurisdiction of the yard foreman or designated switchman. The signal will clear only after the low level route selector has been operated by yard personnel. See Bulletin S65-80.
