# Service bulletin

TO: All Concerned, Rail

SUBJECT: Single Track Movement, Douglas Branch, West-Northwest Route

EFFECTIVE: Sunday, July 20, 1980 - 0500 Hours to 2000 Hours

On Sunday, July 20, 1980 the West-Northwest Route will operate according to the following special supplement.

The southbound/westbound track between the crossovers at 18th and Oakley will be out of service from 0500 hours to 2000 hours.

### SINGLE TRACK ZONE

A single track zone will be in effect on the northbound/eastbound track between the crossovers at 18th and Oakley.

### WORK TO BE DONE

The Structure Group of the Maintenance Department will install brackets and erect new platform extensions at 18th Street Station, Douglas Branch, West-Northwest Route.

### ROUTING

Southbound/westbound Normal to clear right-hand crossover at 18th. Pilot will board rear of train and pull back the train through the crossover to the northbound/eastbound track. On orders of the pilot and proper signals, motormen will operate southbound/westbound on the northbound/eastbound track to and through the right-hand crossover at Oakley and then proceed normal.
