TO: All Concerned, Rail

SUBJECT: Single Track Movement, Lake Street Branch, West-South Route

EFFECTIVE: Sunday, August 10, 1980 - 0100 Hours to 0700 Hours

On Sunday, August 10, 1980 the West-South Route will operate according to the following special supplement.

The northbound/westbound track between the crossovers at Avers and Austin will be out of service from 0100 hours to 0700 hours.

SINGLE TRACK ZONE

A single track zone will be in effect on the eastbound/southbound track between the crossovers at Austin and Avers.

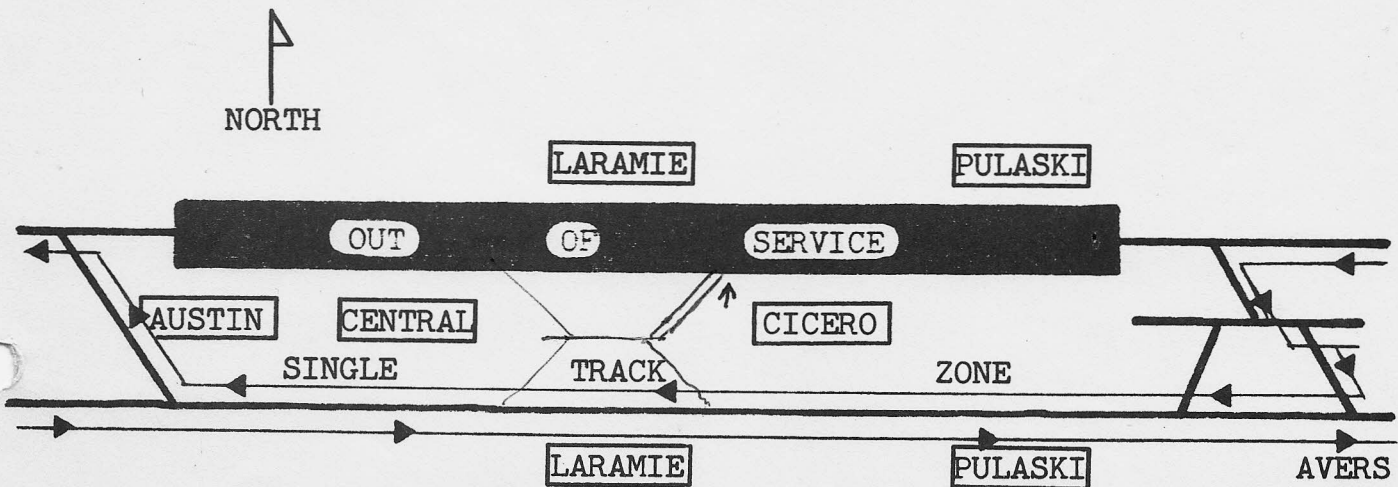
WORK TO BE DONE

The Track Group of the Maintenance Department will remove an existing left-hand turnout and install a new turnout on the northbound/westbound track, east of Laramie Station, Lake Street Branch, West-South Route.

ROUTING

Northbound/westbound Normal to clear switch at Avers. Pilot will board rear of train and pull back the train through the crossover to the center track and then through the right-hand crossover at Avers to the eastbound/southbound track. On orders of the pilot and proper signals, motormen will operate northbound/westbound on the eastbound/southbound track to and through the right-hand crossover west of Austin Station and then proceed normal.
