TO: All Concerned, Rail
 SUBJECT: Reroute, Howard Branch, North-South Route
 EFFECTIVE: Sunday, November 2, 1980 - 0800 Hours to 1630 Hours

On Sunday, November 2, 1980 the North-South Route will operate according to the regular schedule. However, southbound track #2 from Howard Street to north of Granville Station will be out of service from 0800 hours to 1630 hours.

WORK TO BE DONE

A contractor will be painting the edge of the new platform canopy at the Loyola Station, Howard Branch, North-South Route.

REROUTE

Southbound Proceed south on track #1 to and through the left-hand crossover north of the Granville Station onto track #2. Then proceed normal.

Northbound Proceed normal.

SPECIAL NOTICE

Southbound Conductors must make the following announcement at Howard Street Station. "This train will not stop at Jarvis, Morse and Loyola Stations. Passengers who wish to alight at these stations must take this train to Granville Station, then take a northbound train back to your intending station." Agents at Jarvis, Morse and Loyola Stations must make the following announcement to southbound passengers. "Southbound passengers must take a northbound train to Howard Station, alight and then take any southbound train to your destination."

MAXIMUM PERMITTED SPEED, SUBJECT TO RULES AND HAND SIGNALS, MUST NOT EXCEED 35 MPH.
