SPECIAL NOTICE

The last normal train will be run #420 due to leave Kimball Terminal at 1923 hours. The first train through the reroute will be run #422 due to leave Kimball Terminal at 1933 hours.

A towerman will be on duty at Tower #12.

<u>REROUTE</u> Normal to Tower #18. Towerman will route train eastbound onto inner loop. Towerman will route train westbound on the inner loop at Tower #12. Towerman will route train northbound onto Ravenswood Route at Tower #18.

Conductors must make the following announcement when leaving the Merchandise Mart. "This train will stop at all stations around the loop." Conductors must announce to intending passengers at Clark/Lake, State/Lake, Randolph/ Wabash, Madison/Wabash and Adams/Wabash their destination and classification.

Motormen must operate with extreme caution in the reroute area and be prepared to honor any signal.

Workmen will be on the track at the work site approximately one-half hour before and after the scheduled time of the reroute operation.
