# Service bulletin

TO: All Concerned, Rail

SUBJECT: Single Track Movement, Douglas Branch, West-Northwest Route

EFFECTIVE: Sunday, May 17, 1981 - 1400 Hours to 2000 Hours

On Sunday, May 17, 1981 the West-Northwest Route will operate according to the following special supplement.

The southbound track between the crossovers at Morgan Middle Track and Polk Street will be out of service from 1400 hours to 2000 hours.

## SINGLE TRACK ZONE

A single track zone will be in effect on the northbound track between the Polk Street crossover and the Morgan Middle Track.

## WORK TO BE DONE

The Track Group of the Maintenance Department will install rail between Congress Parkway and Harrison on the southbound track, Douglas Branch, West-Northwest Route.

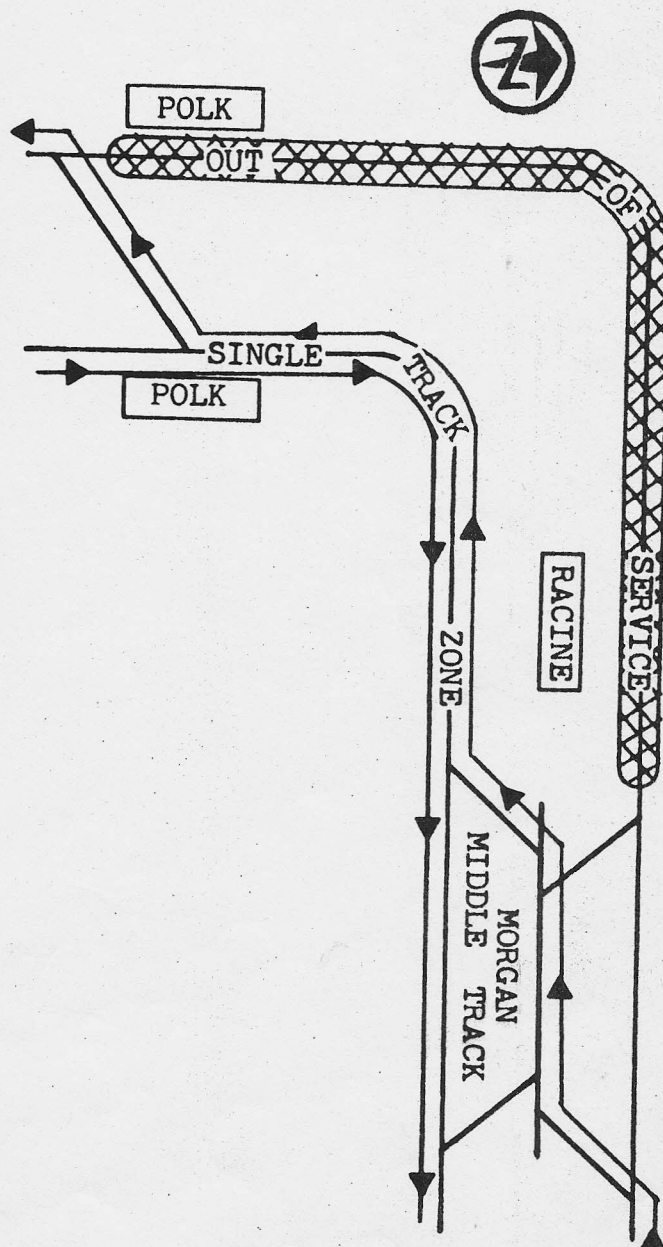
## ROUTING

Southbound (Douglas) Normal to Morgan Middle Track. On proper signals from the switchman, motormen will enter Morgan Middle Track and proceed to west end of the Morgan Middle track. Pilot will board train in the Morgan Middle Track. On order of the pilot and proper signals, motormen will operate southbound on the northbound track to and through the right-hand crossover at Polk Street and then proceed normal.
