SUBJECT: Single Track Movement, Outer Loop, West-South Route

EFFECTIVE: Saturday, July 11, 1981 - 2100 Hours to
Sunday, July 12, 1981 - 0900 Hours

On Saturday, July 11 through Sunday, July 12, 1981 the West-South Route will operate according to the following special supplement.

The southbound track between the crossovers south of Randolph and Adams Streets over Wabash Avenue will be out of service from 2100 hours on Saturday, July 11 to 0900 hours on Sunday, July 12, 1981.

SINGLE TRACK ZONE

A single track zone will be in effect on the northbound track between the crossovers south of Adams and Randolph Streets.

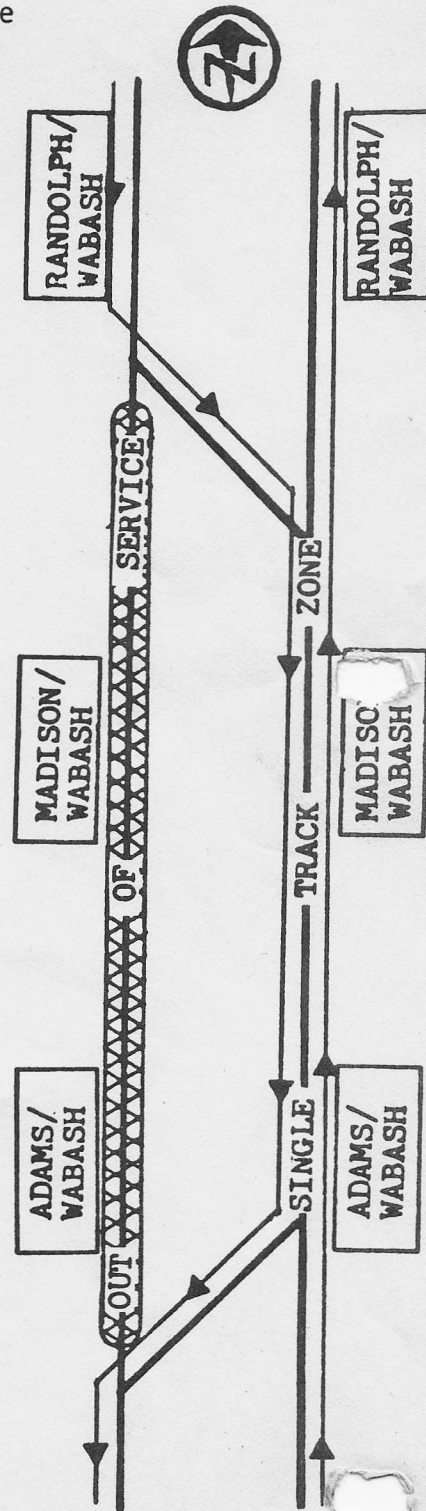
WORK TO BE DONE

The Structure Group of the Maintenance Department will renew span #319 and remove tracks and steel girders and install box girders on the inner loop at Washington Street over Wabash Avenue, West-South Route.

ROUTING

Southbound Normal to crossover south of Randolph/Wabash Station. Pilot will board train on double track at Randolph/Wabash Station. On orders of the pilot and proper signals, motormen will operate to and through the crossover onto the northbound track. Motormen will operate southbound on the northbound track to and through the tower-controlled crossover at Tower #12.

Northbound Normal on orders of pilot.
