SUBJECT: Single Track Movement, Lake Street Branch, West-South Route

EFFECTIVE: Saturday, December 5, 1981 - 2100 Hours to
Monday, December 7, 1981 - 0500 Hours

On Saturday, December 5, 1981 through Monday, December 7, 1981 the West-South Route will operate according to the following special supplement.

The northbound track between the Laramie middle track and the right-hand crossover west of the Austin Station will be out of service during the time shown above.

SINGLE TRACK ZONE

A single track zone will be in effect on the southbound track between the right-hand crossover west of the Austin Station and the Laramie middle track.

WORK TO BE DONE

The Track Group of the Maintenance Department will connect the new westbound track between Central and Austin Stations and modify the west side of Central platform and the east side of Austin platform, Lake Street Branch, West-South Route.

Northbound Normal to Laramie middle track. On proper line-up, motormen will operate into the Laramie middle track and proceed to the west end of the track. Pilot will board train on double track at the west end of the Laramie middle track. On orders of pilot and proper signals, motormen will operate onto the southbound track. Motormen will operate northbound on the southbound track to and through the right-hand crossover west of the Austin Station and then proceed normal.

Southbound Normal on orders of pilot.
