EFFECTIVE:

Sunday, June 17, 1990 - 1830 hours to Monday, June 18, 1990 - 0500 hours

As indicated above, a reroute of **southbound** North-South trains will be in effect between Clark Junction and 17th Street. **Southbound** trains will operate over the elevated tracks instead of the State Street subway. CTA Engineer K-851A, Channel 2, will be in charge of the work site.

TRACK OUT OF SERVICE

Southbound track between Armitage and 17th Street.

SPECIAL ROUTING

North-South/southbound trains will be rerouted via the Ravenswood route from Clark Junction to Tower #18 and via the West-South route from Tower #18 to 17th Street.

While operating via the above reroute, southbound North-South trains will stop at:

Belmont Fullerton Chicago/Franklin

State/Lake Randolph/Wabash Madison/Wabash Adams/Wabash

At 17th Street, switchmen will be on duty to return North-South trains to their route. All West-South motormen will be required to change their destination signs to "Not in Service" when leaving Adams/Wabash (to display white marker lights) and must return their sign setting to "Lake-Dan Ryan All Stop" after leaving 17th Street.

yellow - Englewood green - Jackson Park

white - Dan Ryan and any extra trains

Northbound Proceed normally through the State Street subway.

SPECIAL NOTICE

- . Clark Junction towerman will be responsible for routing the North-South trains onto the Ravenswood route.
- . Tower #18 towerman will be responsible for routing North-South trains onto the West-South route.
- Chicago/Franklin and Madison/Wabash stations will be open.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

NORTH-SOUTH CONDUCTORS:

• Southbound while standing at, and when leaving Wilson, Sheridan, Addison, Belmont and Fullerton stations:

"This southbound train will not operate into the State Street Subway. It will operate over the elevated structure stopping at Chicago/Franklin, Clark/Lake, State/Lake, Randolph/Wabash, Madison/Wabash and Adams/Wabash stations."

Northbound while standing at every subway station:

"Southbound trains are not operating in the subway. Board **southbound** trains at Chicago/Franklin, Clark/Lake, State/Lake, Randolph/Wabash, Madison/Wabash and Adams/Wabash."

WEST-NORTHWEST CONDUCTORS:

· In both directions at Jackson, Washington and Lake Transfer:

"Southbound North-South Subway trains are being rerouted over the Loop elevated structure. Passengers changing to **southbound** Englewood or Jackson Park trains must leave this train at Lake Transfer Station and transfer at the Clark/Lake elevated station."

"Northbound North-South trains are running normally in the subway."

WEST-SOUTH CONDUCTORS:

 Southbound approaching, and while standing at, Clark/Lake and State/Lake stations:

"Southbound North-South Subway trains are being rerouted over the Loop elevated structure. Passengers changing to **southbound** Englewood or Jackson Park trains must leave this train at State/Lake and wait on this platform for your train."

"Passengers for Roosevelt Road should transfer to the '29 State Street' bus at State/Lake."

"Northbound North-South trains are running normally in the subway."

· Northbound at Adams/Wabash, Randolph/Wabash and State/Lake:

"Southbound North-South subway trains are being rerouted over the Loop elevated structure. **Southbound** Englewood and Jackson Park trains will stop at Loop stations between Adams/Wabash and Clark/Lake."

"Northbound North-South trains are running normally in the subway."

RAIL CONTROLLERS:

Southbound State Street Subway stations:

"Southbound North-South Subway trains are being rerouted over the elevated structure. Englewood and Jackson Park trains are stopping at Chicago/Franklin, Clark/Lake, State/Lake, Randolph/Wabash, Madison/Wabash and Adams/Wabash."

RIDER ALERT:

 All employees are to use the attached "Rider Alert" when answering passenger questions.

Agents at Clark/Division, Chicago/State, Grand, Washington, Monroe, Jackson and Roosevelt stations must advise southbound passengers: "Southbound trains will operate over the elevated tracks between Fullerton Avenue and 17th Street." Agents will direct southbound passengers to the nearest supplement service as outlined by the attached "Rider Alert."
