As shown above, the **Southbound Track** between Jefferson and Franklin Streets will be out of service while CTA forces renew flange angles. Ironworker Foreman A. Flores, K-464, channel 2, will be in charge of the work site.


### SINGLE TRACK ZONE

A single track zone will be in effect on the Northbound Track between Jefferson and Franklin crossovers.

### ROUTING

<u>Southbound</u> Normal into Clinton Station. On receipt of proper signals, pull-back motorman or pilot will operate onto the Northbound Track. Motormen will operate east on the Northbound Track to the right-hand crossover at Franklin. On orders of the pilot and receipt of proper signals, operate onto the Southbound Track and then proceed normal.

Northbound Normal on orders of pilot and receipt of proper signals.



## SPECIAL NOTICE

- Switchmen will be on duty at Jefferson and Franklin crossovers.
- Cab signals in the single track zone will display aspects as usual in the northbound direction.
- There will be no cab signals for trains in the southbound direction in the single track zone. Cab signals will <u>cut-out</u> at Jefferson and <u>cut-in</u> when leaving Franklin crossover.

- Bridge signal #36 will be hooded, #33 switch will be clamped in the reverse position and trips #33A and #33B will be pinned.
- In the event of a request to lift the bridge, towerman at Tower #18 must notify the city bridge tender that it will take a minimum of 15 minutes before power can be given to the city, while signal #36 is unhooded, switch #33 is unclamped and thrown to the normal position and trips #33A and #33B are unpinned.
- Motormen must not exceed 35 mph while operating through the single track zone in either direction.
- Workmen will be on the track at the work site approximately one-half hour before and after the scheduled time of the single track operation.
