# Service Bulletin

TO: All Concerned, Rail  
SUBJECT: Operation of Weed Sprayer Train, Evanston Route  
EFFECTIVE: Tuesday, April 2, 1991

As shown above, the weed sprayer train will spray weeds between 2300 and 0400 hours as follows:

<u>DIRECTION</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>
Northbound	Howard and Linden
Southbound	Linden and Howard

The weed spray solution is greasy, so it may affect operating conditions on the running rails. Employees operating trains on tracks which have been sprayed are cautioned to be extremely careful in the operation of their trains. The rails may be slippery for some time after the work is completed.


Spraying depends on weather conditions. **Watch bulletin boards carefully for deviation from the above schedule.**


The weed sprayer train will put out from and lay up in 63rd Lower Yard.

**Note: The operation of the weed sprayer train will be under the jurisdiction of the track foreman aboard.**


