EFFECTIVE: Monday, April 8, 1991 - 0900 hours to 1500 hours
Tuesday, April 9, 1991 - 0900 hours to 1500 hours
Wednesday, April 10, 1991 - 0900 hours to 1500 hours
Thursday, April 11, 1991 - 0900 hours to 1500 hours
Friday, April 12, 1991 - 0900 hours to 1500 hours

As shown above, CTA track forces will spread ballast on tracks 1, 2, 3, and 4 between Howard and Wilson, North-South Route.


Motormen must operate with extreme caution in the area where the ballast train is working and be prepared to honor any signal given.

The train will leave Skokie Yard and proceed to South Boulevard to load ballast. Upon completion of loading, the train will spread ballast under traffic between Howard and Wilson. The train will lay up at Skokie Shops yard on completion of the days work.

Note: The entire operation will be under the jurisdiction of the Rail Supervisor aboard.


