



## **MODERN MOTOR BUSES FOR 63rd STREET TRANSIT RIDERS**

Beginning Sunday, May 24, 1953, modern motor buses are replacing old red streetcars on 63rd Street Route No. 63, providing more frequent service and quieter operation for riders of this line.

The modern 63rd Street buses are to be operated between terminals at Stony Island on the east and Narragansett Avenue on the west.

Bus service is to be confined to 63rd Street, except for the necessary turnarounds at the east and west terminals. Presently the line operates on 63rd Place between South Central Avenue and South Narragansett Avenue.

A route map of the new bus service appears on the reverse side of this leaflet.
