

- 2200 series, built by Budd in 1969-1970. Running on Blue and Pink Lines- many have already been scrapped.
- 2400 series, built by Boeing in 1976-1978. Found on Green, Red, and Orange, and next to be replaced by 5000s.
- 2600 series, built by Budd/Transit America in 1981-1987. Largest fleet of any type- they run on several lines.
- 3200 series, built by Morrison-Knudsen in 1992-1994. First computerized cars, on Brown, Orange, and Yellow.

#### Specific equipment CANNOT be guaranteed and is subject to change by the CTA.

To assemble this unique train, CTA needs to transfer some cars between lines. Rather than "deadhead" without passengers, we can use this opportunity to give you a choice in the length of your trip, boarding location, and fare: From Midway on the Orange Line, we'll leave at about 9:15 am, and return you there at about 6:00 pm. Or... From Forest Park on the Blue Line (Congress), the trip begins at about 8:00 am, and finishes at about 7:15 pm. For the Midway-Midway trip, the fare is **\$47.00** per person, and for the Forest Park-Forest Park trip, **\$55.00** per person. Parking is available for \$5 at both Midway and Forest Park. Riders may also board at Racine on the Blue Line at approximately 10:00 am. We will make stops for passengers who wish to leave the train early upon request.

Lunch: An hour will be given for lunch on your own at stops around the Loop; a list of suggested restaurants will be provided. All cars except the 2200 series are wheelchair-accessible; consult CTA for station accessibility.

Past Snowflake Specials have sold out and we've had to turn purchasers away. You are strongly advised to buy your tickets in advance.

## 2013 IRM Snowflake Special Car Captain Info Sheet

First of all, **thank you** for acting as a car captain during this year's trip. It was a challenge finding a sufficient number of volunteers to sufficiently cover an 8-car "L" train, and your participation is greatly appreciated.

Although most volunteers on this year's trip have experience as car captains/hosts on previous Snowflake Specials, it's always good to remember the following points to ensure a safe and enjoyable trip for our guests:

- **DO** ensure that passengers' questions about the trip (or the CTA) are answered. If you don't know the answer, chances are another car captain does.

- **DON'T** open any windows on the train. Although the keys we have are capable of doing so, open windows let heat escape from the car and can be a safety risk to passengers.

- **DO** feel free to move about the train or disembark for photo stops, provided the car you are assigned to is covered by another car captain.

- **DON'T** allow guests into unused cabs within the train. We will be using some of these for storage of large items (historic signage, etc). Additionally, some controls in cabs remain "live" even if that cab is not in use and can be triggered unintentionally. Guests may ask CTA personnel to view cabs at each end of the train while the train is stopped at stations.

- **DO** periodically check on the well-being of the guests in your car(s). If a rider experiences a medical emergency, notify a car captain at either end of the train via radio. CTA personnel on the train will then radio the control center, who will arrange for emergency personnel to meet the train at a specific location.

**DON'T** hesitate to contact other car captains, and/or CTA personnel on the train, if you observe an unsafe situation of any type which could jeopardize the safety of those on or off the train.

- **DO** remember that you are representing IRM during this trip. In the past our Snowflake guests have experienced many delays and a few other issues here and there, but consistently remain in good spirits because of our excellent volunteers. Let's keep up the good work!
