On Sunday, August 8, 1954, A Fan Trip will be operated over the Chicago, Aurora and Elgin Railroad. The trip will leave the Forest Park Terminal and cover the main line to Wheaton, The branches to Aurora and Elgin, the Batavia branch, and part of the abandoned Mt. Carmel line. Photo stops will be made at various locations. A lunch stop will be made at Aurora. Inspection of equipment at Wheaton shops will be permitted.

The trip will leave the Forest Park Terminal, Des Plaines Avenue, at 9:00 A.M. The Terminal may be reached by taking the C.T.A. Garfield Park "L" trains west bound. There are adequate parking facilities at Forest Park for those driving.
