ACTIVITY: Historic Train

LOCATION: Damen

EFFECTIVE: Sunday, May 18, 1997 - 0930 to 1400 Hours

Sunday, May 18, 1997 marks the 90th anniversary of the Brown Line. CTA will celebrate this occasion at the historic Damen Avenue Station. This event is being sponsored by Ravenswood Hospital, located one block from the station. The hospital is marking its 90th anniversary this year and is adopting the Damen Avenue Station as part of the neighborhood adopt-a-station plan.

CTA historic cars 4271-4272 will be on a static display on the southbound track over Damen Avenue. The track will be out of service and a single track will be in effect on the northbound track while structure maintenance is being performed south of Wilson Avenue. The historic train will leave Kimball at approximately 0930 hours, and proceed directly to Damen. Upon request, the cars will be moved into the sun for photographs. Upon completion, the train will return to Kimball and lay up.
