

A MID-SUMMER NIGHT'S TRAIN – Friday, July 18, 1980

The Chicago Chapter of the National Federation of the Blind of Illinois cordially invites you to join the party! Enjoy the warm summer evening breezes and the sounds and feel of the CTA's restored antique train, cars 4271 and 4272. This is a rare opportunity to ride 80 miles on the 4000's in one evening. The train will depart Howard (southbound platform) at 1800 hours and pick up passengers at the Belmont station (north end of southbound platform) at 1805 hours, and at the Washington station north end of platform (at Lake Street stairs) at 1815 hours. The trip will cover the following routes:

Howard to Jackson Park via Track 1 (the express track) to Wilson and the State Street subway; Jackson Park to Ravenswood via the subway; Ravenswood to Lake via the Loop "L"; Lake to Evanston via the Loop; Evanston to Howard Terminal. There will be photo stops in the subway at Grand (southbound) and Roosevelt (northbound), and rest stops at Jackson Park, Kimball, and Harlem Terminals respectively.

The cost is \$14 per person in advance and \$15 on the train. The ticket price includes sandwiches, soft drinks, wine, and live entertainment. Checks should be made payable to NFBI, Chicago Chapter. Payment by cash is also acceptable. The ticket cost is tax deductible.

Tickets are available at Downtown Hobby Service, 22 West Madison Street, Chicago, in the subway arcade, and the Illinois Railway Museum, Union, Illinois.
