In late January 1989, the CTA took St. Louis-built rapid transit cars #6597-98 (1957) out of mothballs and repainted them in the Mint Green and Alpine White color scheme. These are the first cars painted in these "old" colors in many years. Since the 6000-series rapid transit cars are to be retired in several years, and are now relegated to rush-hour service only, the ILLINOIS RAILWAY MUSEUM has arranged for an excursion with these cars on Sunday, April 9, 1989.

Routes to be covered include Ravenswood, Evanston Express, Dan Ryan and North/South.

The trip has been specifically designed for the railfan photographer to capture these two repainted cars on film. Nine photo stops have been planned with adequate time at each location to take pictures to your heart's content. This will not be the typically rushed photo-stop type of fantrip.

ALL PROCEEDS FROM THE FANTRIP WILL BE USED TO PURCHASE SPARE PARTS FROM THE CTA FOR THE MUSEUM'S 6000'S -- #6125-26 AND #6461-62.

Tickets are \$35.00 for ADULTS and \$20.00 for CHILDREN if purchased before the day of the trip. Tickets purchased on the day of the trip will be \$40,00 for ADULTS and \$25.00 for CHILDREN. When ordering, please enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope. DO NOT SEND CASH. Tickets ordered after March 29, 1989 will be distributed on the day of the trip.

Ticket sales will be limited to the seating capacity of the two cars (100), so order your tickets now. Don't be left behind on the platform!
