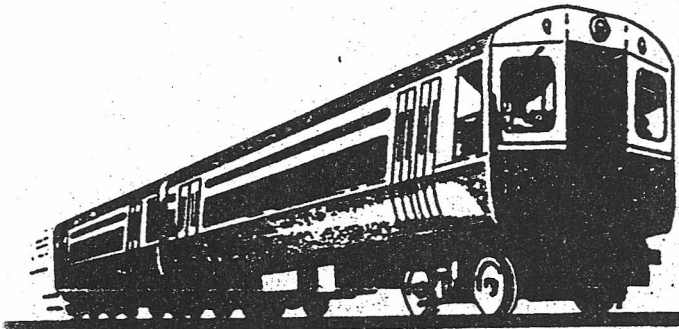

FAREWELL TO PCC'S IN CHICAGO
Sunday, April 13, 1997

Join the members of the Illinois Railway Museum as they tour the Chicago Transit Authority's "L"-Subway lines. The trip will cover parts or all of every color line on the system, including the connector track. The trip will begin at Harlem and Lake on the Green Line. We will cover all of the Green, Orange, and Purple Lines and portions of the Blue, Red, Brown and Yellow Lines.

Equipment will be a five-car train of 5-50 series cars. These cars were removed from regular service in 1993 and have seen limited service since then. Most of the cars are used in non-revenue service (work trains) but are soon to be retired. This may be one of the last opportunities to ride a PCC in Chicago.

Fares: \$25.00 Adults (\$35.00 day of trip)
\$15.00 Children 5-17 (\$20.00 day of trip)
\$70.00 Family (\$90.00 day of trip) Maximum 2 adults 3 children.
Orders received after April 5 will be held for pick up on train.
No refunds after April 8, 1997.

Lunch: A lunch stop will be provided in the Loop.

Departure: From Harlem and Lake at 8:58am.
From 54th/Cermak (Blue Line) at 10:00am.

Note: Because we are covering so many lines the trip will conclude at Harlem at about 6:00pm. We will make earlier stops by request.
