## \*\*\* CTA CORNER \*\*\*

On February 6, 1996, the CTA put up for bid all the spare GMC parts they had in stock.

Also, a CTA report dated February 9, 1996, indicated that NO GMC's were in service, so this looks like the end for the fishbowl bus in Chicago.

According to sources, the CTA MUST send 75 Flxibles to Atlanta, no ifs, ands, or buts. At this time there is no plan to put the GM's into a contingency fleet.

After the Democratic Convention there are plans to retire at least twenty articulated buses.

When the Green Line 'L' reopens late in March after an extensive \$343 million reconstruction trains will only operate between the hours of 5:00am and midnight, much to the surprise and dismay of some South Siders.

Before the line was closed for reconstruction in 1994, trains ran all night. But CTA administrators say diminishing ridership and the agency's budget crunch led them to cut the hours.

Residents along the Green Line say the schedule change caught them by surprise.

CTA officials concede they recently informed community members about the new hours, even though the schedule change had been in the works since the rehabilitation project had begun.

But the CTA says Green Line communities are not being singled out.

"The South Side is not getting shortchanged," said Elonzo Hill, vice-president of service delivery. "The Ravenswood doesn't run 24 hours a day. Neither does the Midway Orange Line. (CHICAGO SUN-TIMES)

## \*\*\* PACE PATTER \*\*\*

Pace bus lines began accepting CTA monthly passes February 1st - after a year without interchangeable passes between the two transit systems.

CTA has agreed to pay Pace \$125,000 each quarter in exchange for the suburban system's acceptance of its passes.

CTA and Pace shared a weekly and monthly pass system until early 1995, when CTA canceled its passes altogether and Pace created its own \$39 monthly pass. When CTA brought back its monthly pass for \$89 last summer, the two agencies could not agree on interchangeable passes.

Earlier this month, the Pace board accepted CTA's \$500,000 a year reimbursement offer. Pace officials say the new deal is far better than the old.

Before [when the two systems shared passes], Pace had no revenue agreement, Pace just kept the revenues from the passes sold in the suburbs. but the majority of passes were sold in the city and CTA was keeping that revenue.
