
WANTED!

The Illinois Electric Railway Museum urgently requests your help in obtaining one of the old Chicago El gate cars. The last five open-platform cars on the entire El system are out of service and scheduled for a December date with the scrapper. These are cars of the 1001-1059 series, as illustrated above. They were built in the years 1899-1901 by Pullman, American Car and Foundry, and St. Louis, and saw many years of service on the Howard - Jackson Park line.

Your contribution, whether large or small, will be added to the fund to purchase one of these cars and to pay for shipping it to the Museum grounds at North Chicago, Illinois. Should the car be unobtainable (scrapped) by the time

sufficient funds are raised, all money received will be returned to the donors.
