POINTS OF INTEREST ON THE NORTH SHORE LINE

Chicago, Ill.

The fourth financial and industrial city of the world. It has one of the finest park systems in the United States, connected by ninety-seven miles of boulevards. The Union Stock Yards, the center of the world's packing industry, giving employment to over fifty thousand people, is located on one square mile of territory, where thousands of live stock are handled daily. Guides are furnished free for sight-seeing parties.

The Art Institute, the Field Museum, the Municipal Pier, and the Lincoln Park Zoo are always of interest to the visitor.

Ravinia Park

The home of Open Air Grand Opera. During the summer months, the world's greatest artists may be heard at this beautiful park.

Fort Sheridan

One of the old United States Army posts, later used as a General Reconstruction Hospital following the late war.

Naval Station

Located at Great Lakes, Ill., on the North Shore Line. This was the main support of our Navy during the late war, having accommodations for sixty thousand men under roof. Drills, Reviews, Athletic Sports, and Band Concerts are held every Wednesday afternoon.

Milwaukee, Wis.

The metropolis of Wisconsin, is located at the northern terminus of the North Shore Line. While it is a thriving industrial city, it also has many recreational attractions. Its boulevard and park systems are copied by many of our leading cities, and the museum is compared favorably with the National Museum in Washington, D. C.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Baggage. One hundred and fifty pounds of personal baggage will be checked free for each passenger presenting first class ticket. (Baggage in excess of 150 pounds will be charged at rates shown in Baggage Tariff No. 1.) No piece of baggage weighing more than 250 pounds will be accepted as baggage. The Company shall in no case be liable on account of lost or damaged baggage in excess of one hundred dollars.

Bicycles and Baby Carriages. Will be charged for at rate shown in Baggage Tariff No. 1.

Purchase Tickets. Passengers are requested to purchase tickets before entering the cars as conductors are governed by rules they cannot change. In case of a dispute passengers should pay the amount charged, take a receipt, and refer the question to the Superintendent at Highwood, Ill., who will adjust it promptly.

Children's Rates. Children under five years, if accompanied by an adult, free; between five and twelve years, half fare.

Tickets are good for thirty days from date of sale.

Dogs cannot be carried on passenger cars unless muzzled. Small lap dogs will be carried free. Larger dogs will be charged for at rates shown in Baggage Tariff No. 1 and must be confined to baggage compartment or front platform.

Lost and Found Department. Articles found on the cars are turned in to the general office at Highwood, Ill., and can be claimed there. Telephone, Highland Park 532 & 533.

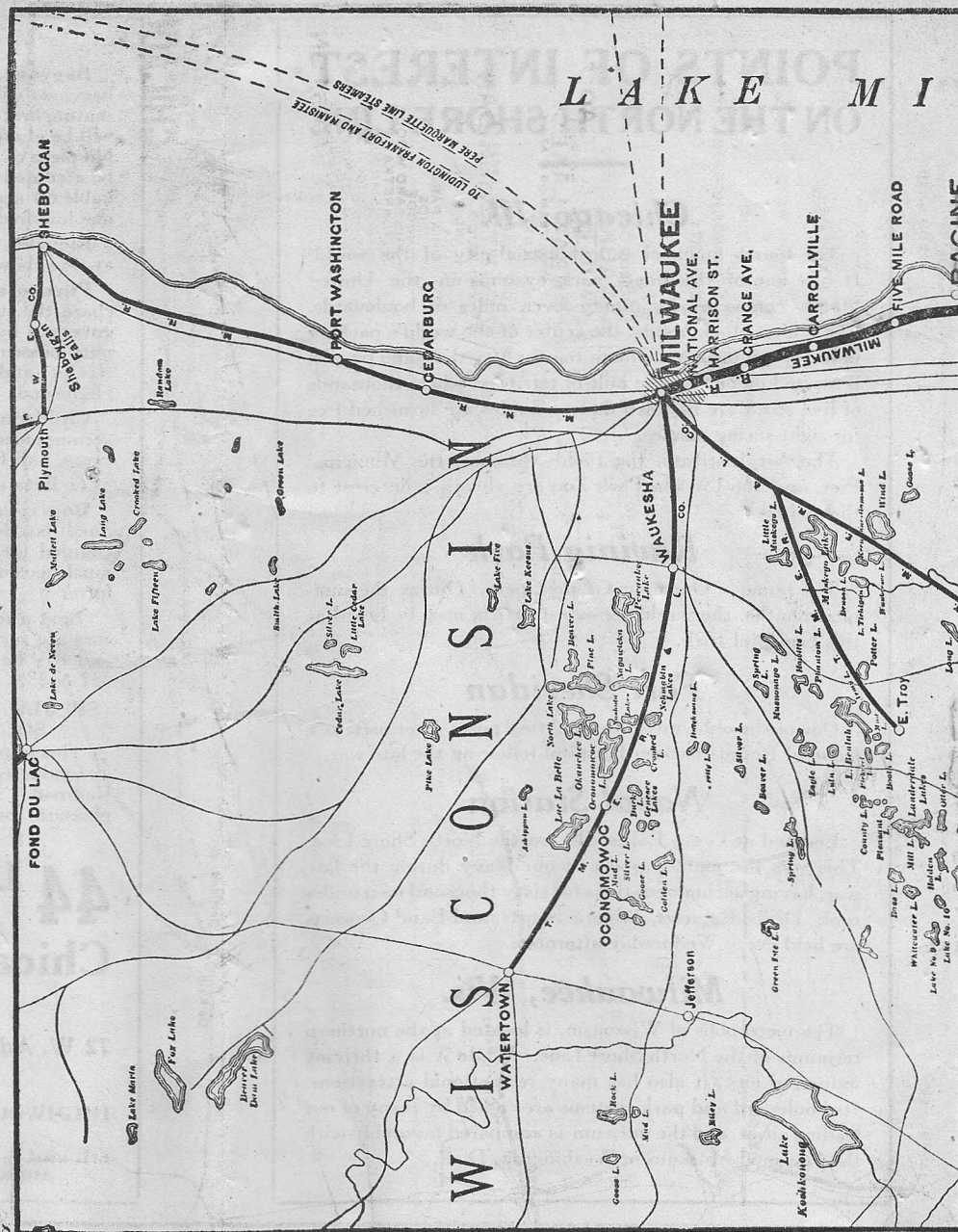

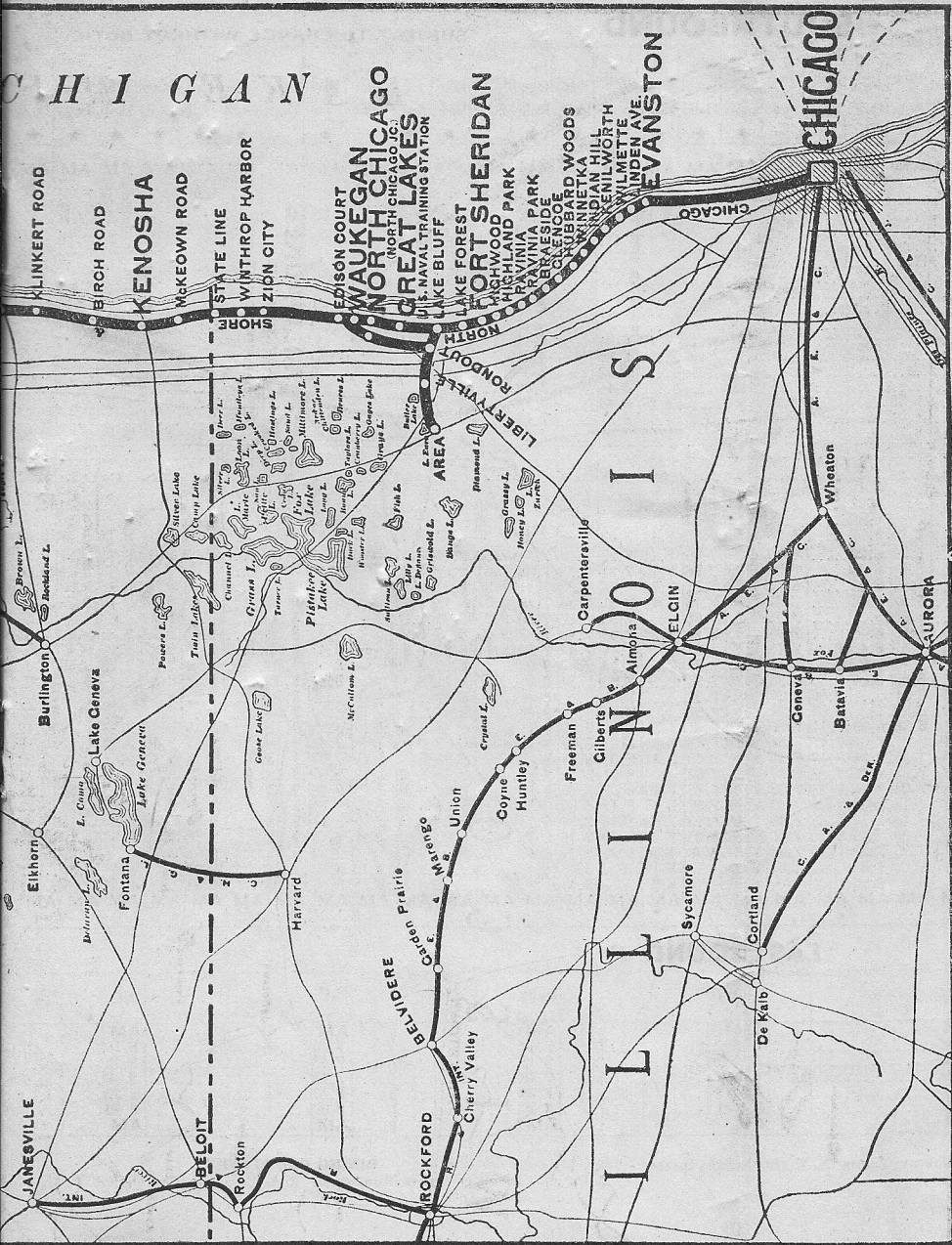
