

#14 – JEFFERY EXPRESS route history

- 01-04-1982 Began CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY bus service Mon-Fri rush only from Michigan-Washington-Clinton-Madison loop via Michigan-Balbo-Columbus-Lake Shore-Coast Guard-Jeffery-Van Vlissingen-100th to Yates-99th-Bensley loop, returning via Lake Shore-Balbo-Michigan
- 12-20-1982 Transferred part of work from 52nd station to 77th station
- 04-25-1983 Transferred all work from 52nd station to 77th station, also discontinued service SB in AM rush and NB in PM rush and extended buses via 100th-Yates to 103rd
- 09-09-1985 Rerouted AM rush buses via Michigan-Madison-Jefferson to Washington, PM rush buses from Jefferson via Washington-Madison
- 06-26-1988 Extended buses via Yates-103rd to Doty East terminal, transferred some AM rush and all PM rush work from 77th station to 103rd station
- 11-09-1996 Rerouted AM rush buses via Lake Shore-Columbus-Balbo
- 09-02-2003 Expanded service to day & early evening, rerouted via 103rd-Torrence-100th, also rerouted via Madison-Jefferson-Randolph-Desplaines-Washington
