

#127 – JACKSON-INDEPENDENCE (Previously CMC #27-JACKSON-INDEPENDENCE) – Bus Route History

Su 03-16-1924 Began CMC #27-JACKSON/INDEPENDENCE bus service from Ridgeway "U" via Douglas-Independence-Hamlin-Jackson to Dearborn-Quincy-State-Jackson loop

We 10-03-1928 Extended buses via Independence-Hamlin to Hamlin-31st-Avers-30th loop

Mo 12-09-1929 Cut back to Douglas/Ridgeway Mon-Sat rush, cut Sundays to shuttle Hamlin/Jackson to Douglas/Ridgeway

Sa 03-08-1930 Cut service to Mon-Sat AM rush eastbound, Mon-Fri PM rush westbound only

We 10-01-1952 Route passes to CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY

Mo 01-26-1953 Rerouted buses westbound via Quincy-State-Van Buren-Canal-Jackson

Su 02-01-1953 Redesignated #127-JACKSON/INDEPENDENCE

Su 11-15-1953 Rerouted buses westbound via Jackson-State-Quincy-Dearborn-Adams-Campbell-Jackson

Su 06-19-1955 Transferred work from Wilcox garage to Kedzie garage

Mo 01-16-1961 Rerouted buses via Jackson-Dearborn-Adams

Sa 01-27-1973 Discontinued service
