I The "loop" or downtown business section of Chicago is used as a basis for the starting point of the various trips shown. By referring to the alphabetical arrangement in the front part of this guide for the point you desire to reach, you will find the trip number to refer to, the distance and fare from the "loop." In the various trips shown, the first column gives the starting point and the points reached, the second column shows the distance to be traveled, the third column shows the cash one way fare, and the fourth column the actual running time in hours and minutes.

I The fares shown are cash one-way fares paid on cars. By purchasing single or round trip tickets at ticket offices, reductions in fares may be had in many instances.
