**Accessibility**  
Metra has 241 commuter rail stations, of which 170 are fully accessible and 22 are partially accessible. The CTA "L" train system includes 146 stations, of which 99 are fully accessible. All CTA and Pace buses are ramp-equipped and make automated stop announcements. Ventra is CTA & Pace's fare payment system, which makes it faster and easier to board and pay. Ventra Transit Accounts can be loaded with value and passing using cash, coins or bank cards at any Ventra vending machine, hundreds of Ventra retailers (payment types accepted may vary), or with credit/debit cards online and by phone.

Cash is accepted on buses. No transfers are issued when paying in cash.

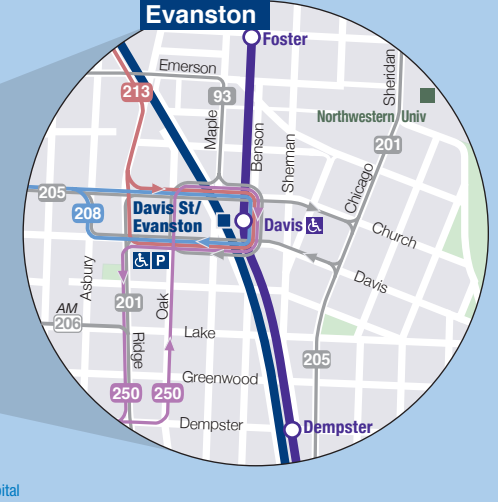

**NICTD (South Shore Line) Fares**

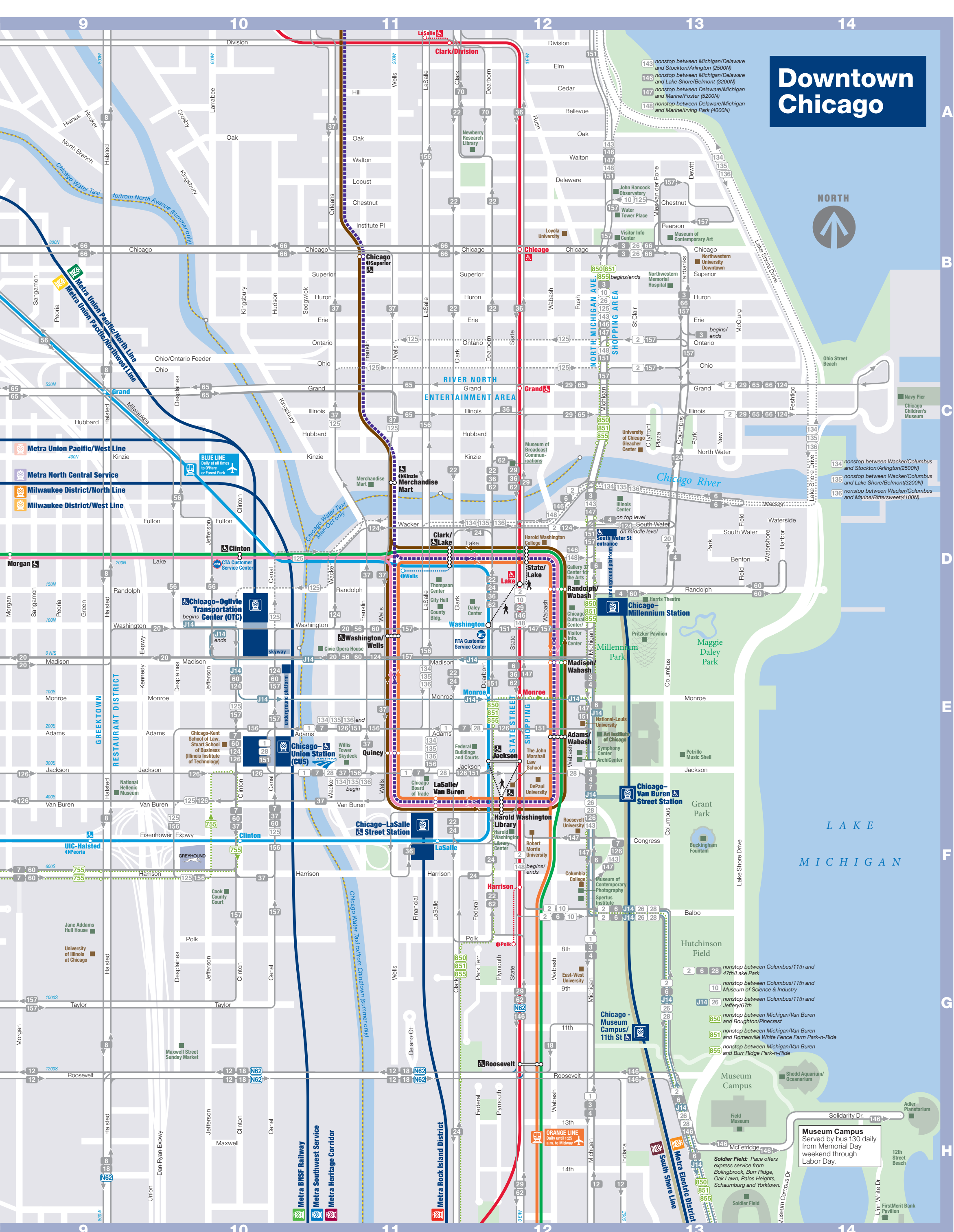
