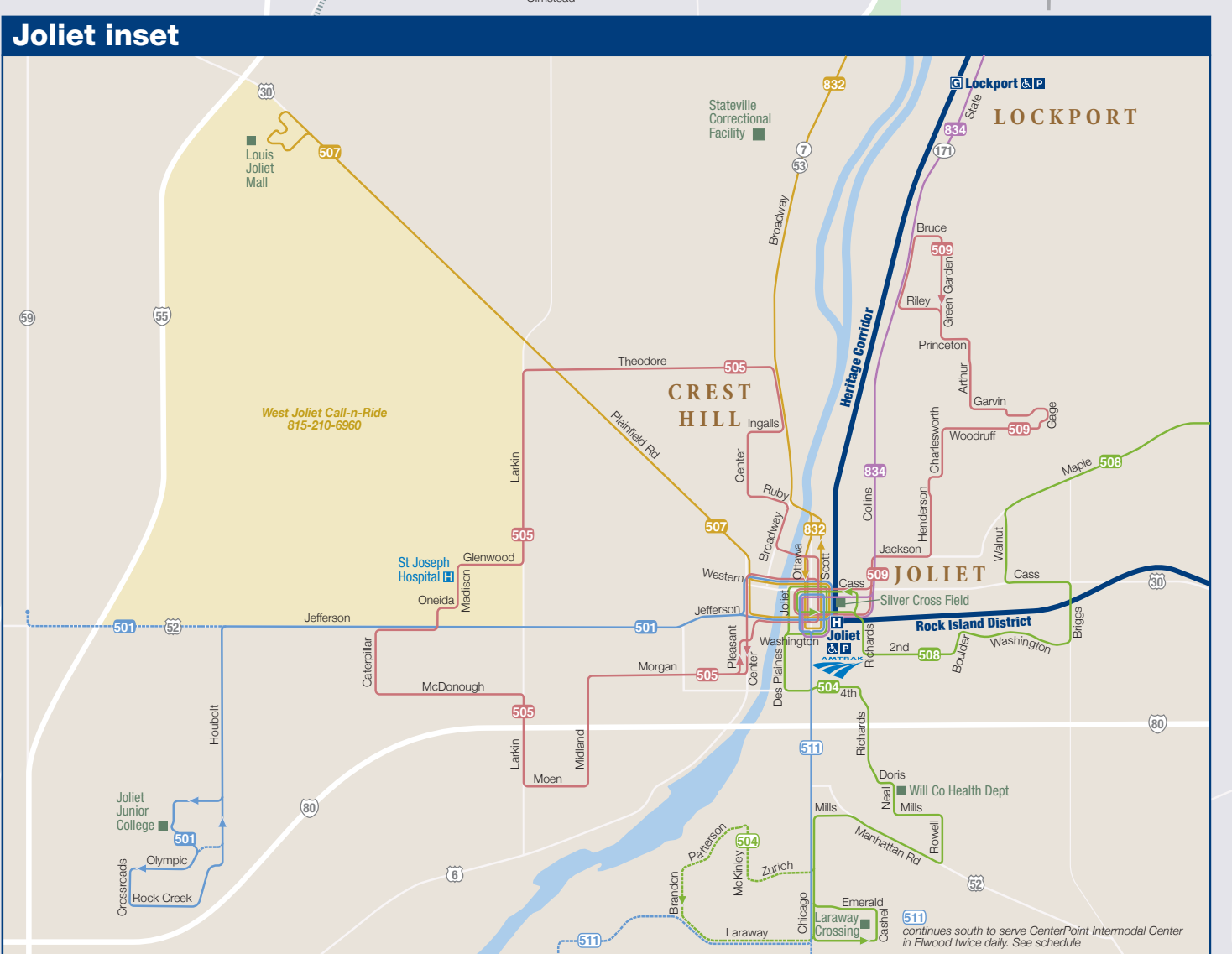
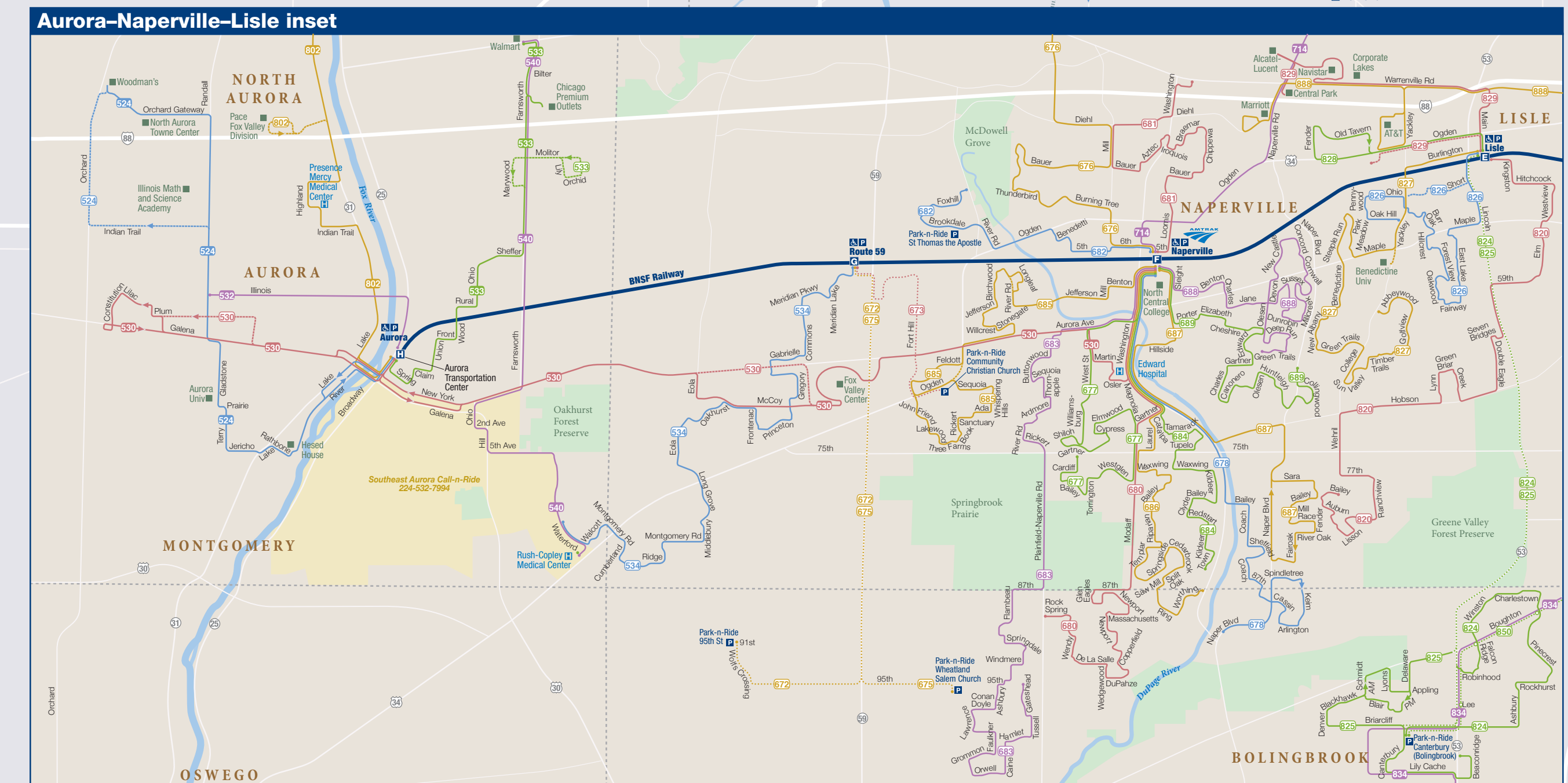
RTA Six-County Regional Map
