

A fresh approach to public transportation

Route 541 Douglas

♦ Serves residential areas of northeast Elgin. Connects Elgin CBD and Metra Station with Sherman Hospital.

Route 542 Grove

♦ Connects the southeast residential areas of Elgin with the Elgin CBD and Metra Station. Service is provided to Elgin High School and Grand Victoria Casino.

Route 543 Dundee

 Provides service along commercial and residential areas of Dundee Avenue and connects with the Elgin CBD and Metra Station. Also serves Wal-Mart and Larsen Junior High School. Select trips serve Carpentersville industrial area and Meadowdale Shopping Center.

Route 544 Chicago Street

 Serves the east side residential area of Elgin, which includes Sherman Health Resource Center of Elgin and provides connection to the Elgin CBD and Metra Station.

Route 545 Walnut

 Provides service from Elgin CBD and Metra Station to residential areas of the southwest side. Serves Larkin High School, Abbott Junior High School and Town & Country Center.

Route 546 South

 Provides service to the southwest residential area of Elgin from the CBD and Metra Station. Serves Elgin Community College, Larkin High School and St. Edward High School.

Route 547 Wing Park

Provides service from Elgin CBD and Metra Station to the northwest residential areas. Provide service to shopping and commercial areas including Wal-Mart on Royal Blvd. and Wing Park Plaza.

Route 548 Highland

 Provides service from the Elgin CBD and Metra Station to west Elgin. Serves various schools, St. Joseph Hospital, Jewel-Otter Creek and Randall Road corridor.

Route 549 McLean

▲ Crosstown route which provides service on the west side of Elgin on McLean Blvd. Serves Elgin Community College, Larkin High School, Fox Bluff Corporate Park and Otter Creek Shopping Center. Connects with all west side routes for service to Elgin terminal.

Route 552 North State - Spring Hill Mall

◆ Provides service from the Elgin ČBD and Metra Station north to Spring Hill Mall. Serves commercial and shopping areas in north Elgin. Selected trips operate to the Miller-Davis Industrial park, First Card and Matsushita on Randall Road.

Route 553 Park / Summit

 Provides service from the Elgin CBD and Metra Station to east side residential areas of Elgin, including Fox Valley Professional Park and Elgin Academy. Route 554 Elgin - Streamwood - Schaumburg

Operates between the Elgin Terminal and Northwest Transit Center via Streamwood. Serves Sherman Health Resource Center, retail along Barrington and Golf Roads, and Woodfield Business Park. Mid-day service is provided to Woodfield Mall. (See North Cook system map for further information.)

Route 555 Elgin - Prairie Stone - Schaumburg

Service is provided between Elgin and the Northwest Transit Center in Schaumburg via Hoffman Estates and Sears Prairie Stone complex. Route 801 Elgin - Geneva

◆ Provides service between Elgin and Geneva, serving the Elgin Terminal, South Elgin, St. Charles Mall, Charlestowne Centre Mall, St. Charles Business park, Geneva Metra Station, and connects with Route 802 for service to Aurora.

Route 802 Aurora - St. Charles

 Provides service between Aurora and St. Charles, serving the Aurora Transportation Center, North Aurora, Batavia, the Geneva Metra Station, St. Charles Business Park, Charlestowne Mall, East and West Dundee.

Route 803 Carpentersville Local

 Serves Spring Hill Mall and Meadowdale Plaza from residential areas in Carpentersville, East and West Dundee, and connects with Route 552 for service to Elgin CBD and Metra Station.

Route 921 Geneva Shuttle

Provides rush hour shuttle service to and from Geneva Metra Station from remote Park-n-Ride lot. Reverse service to Delnor Community Hospital and Kane County Judicial Center in the a.m. only.
