CTA and Pace Fares

Ventra™ is the region's fare payment system, which makes it faster and easier to board and pay. Ventra Transit Accounts can be loaded with value and passes using the Ventra Mobile App, cash, coins or bank cards at any Ventra vending machine, hundreds of Ventra retailers (payment types accepted may vary), or with credit/debit cards online and by phone.

Accessibility






RTA Local Transit Maps


