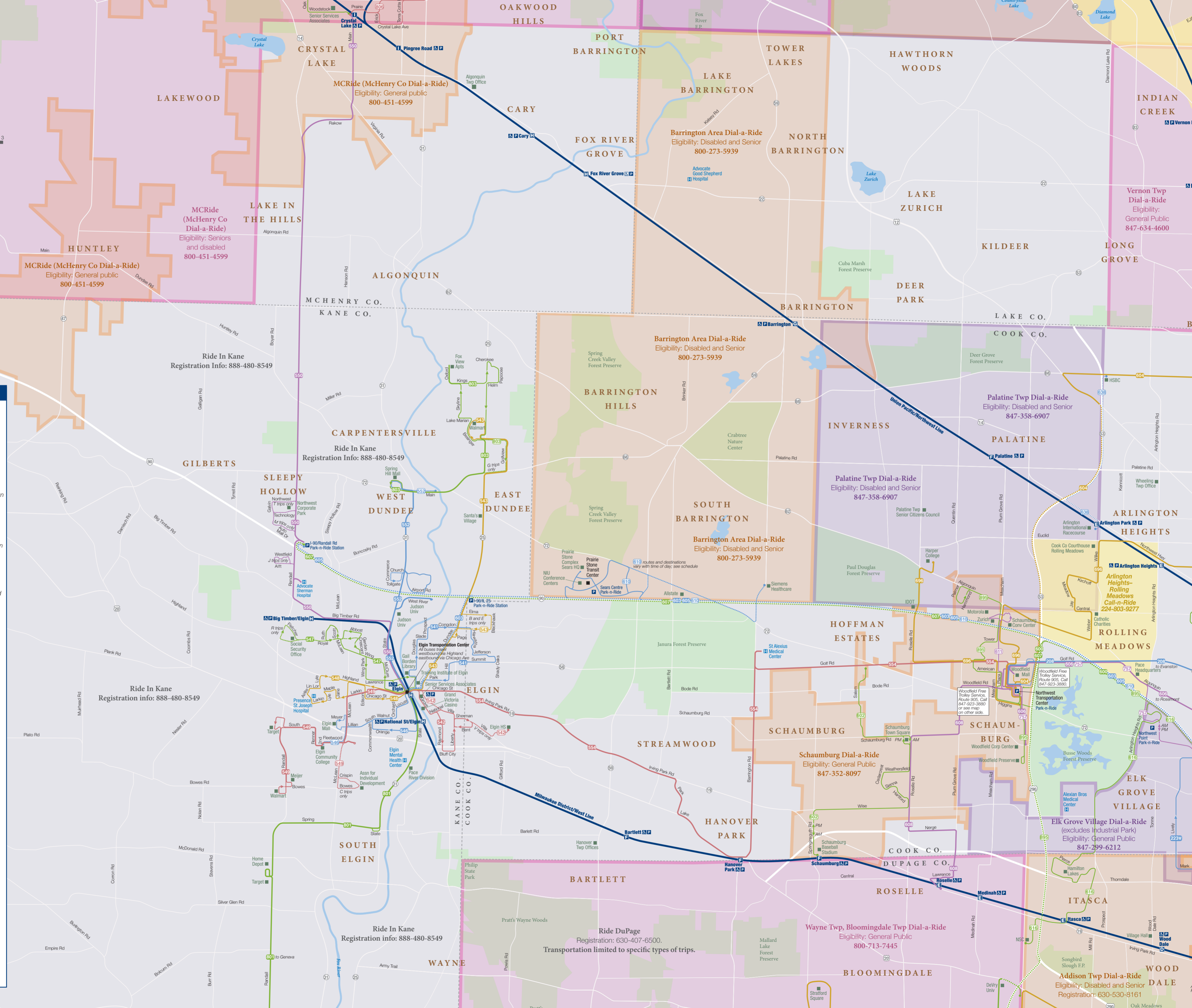

Regional Transportation Authority

The Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) provides financial oversight, funding, and regional transit planning for the three public transit operations in Northeastern Illinois that serve two million riders each weekday: The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA), Metra and Pace bus and paratransit. The Agency provides customer services including on-line and telephone travel planning assistance and travel training for people with disabilities. The RTA is the only transit agency that focuses on the entire region when determining transit planning and funding. The RTA region has a population of approximately eight million people throughout six counties and 7,200 transit route miles. For more information, visit RTAChicago.org



CTA, Metra and Pace

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) runs bus and elevated/subway trains in Chicago and nearby suburbs. For current fare and schedule information, visit transitchicago.com

Metra provides commuter rail services to 242 stations throughout the region serving Chicago and its suburbs. For complete fare and schedule information, visit MetraRail.com

Pace moves people throughout the Chicago region with fixed bus routes, Dial-a-Ride, Call-n-Ride and other community transit programs. Most Pace bus routes connect with Metra and CTA service. For schedules and fares, visit PaceBus.com

Transit Partners

South Shore Line runs trains on the Metra Electric line from downtown Chicago to South Bend, Indiana, serving the Southeast Side of Chicago and Northwest Indiana. For schedules and fares visit nictd.com

Accessibility

Metra has 242 commuter rail stations, of which 171 are fully accessible and 22 are partially accessible. The CTA "L" train system includes 145 stations, of which 101 are fully accessible. All CTA and Pace buses are ramp-equipped and make automated stop announcements. 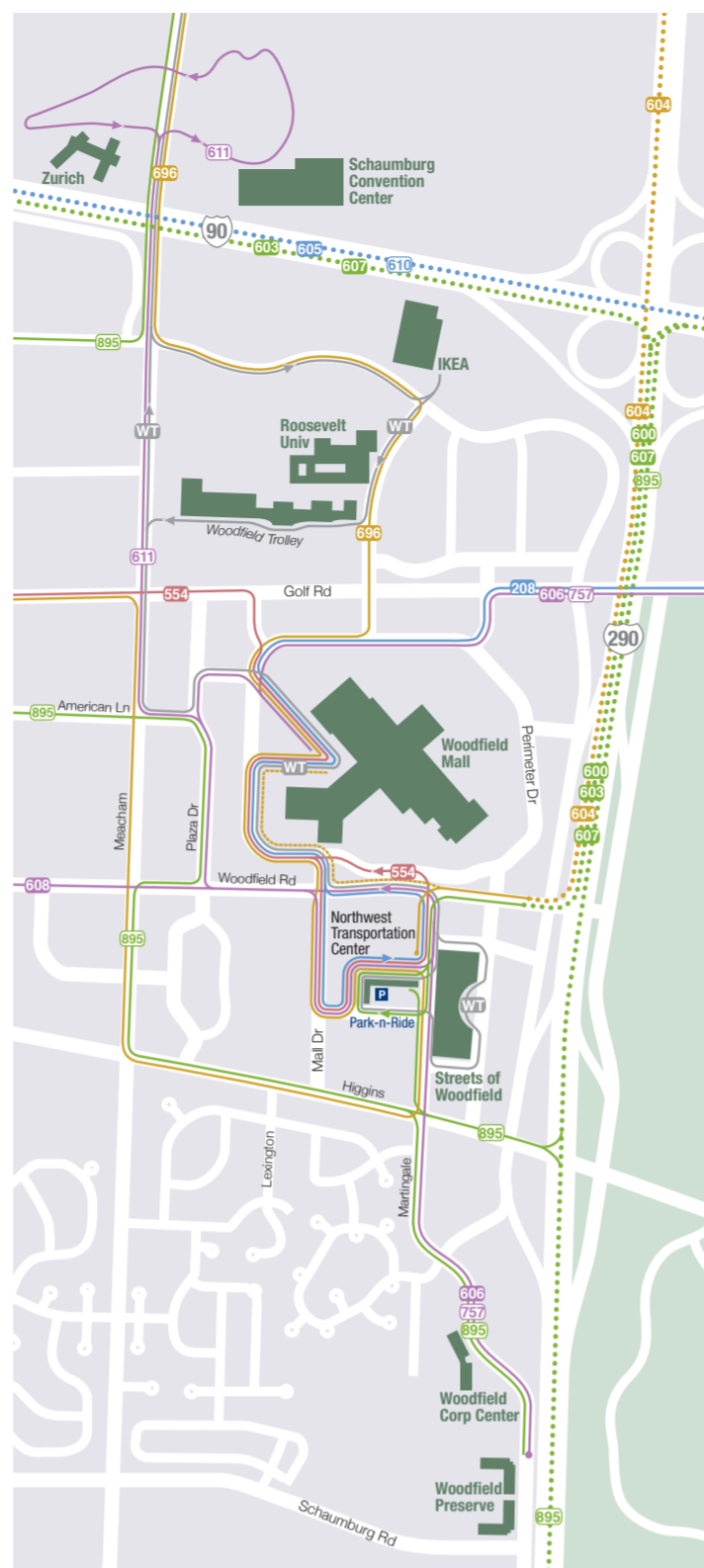

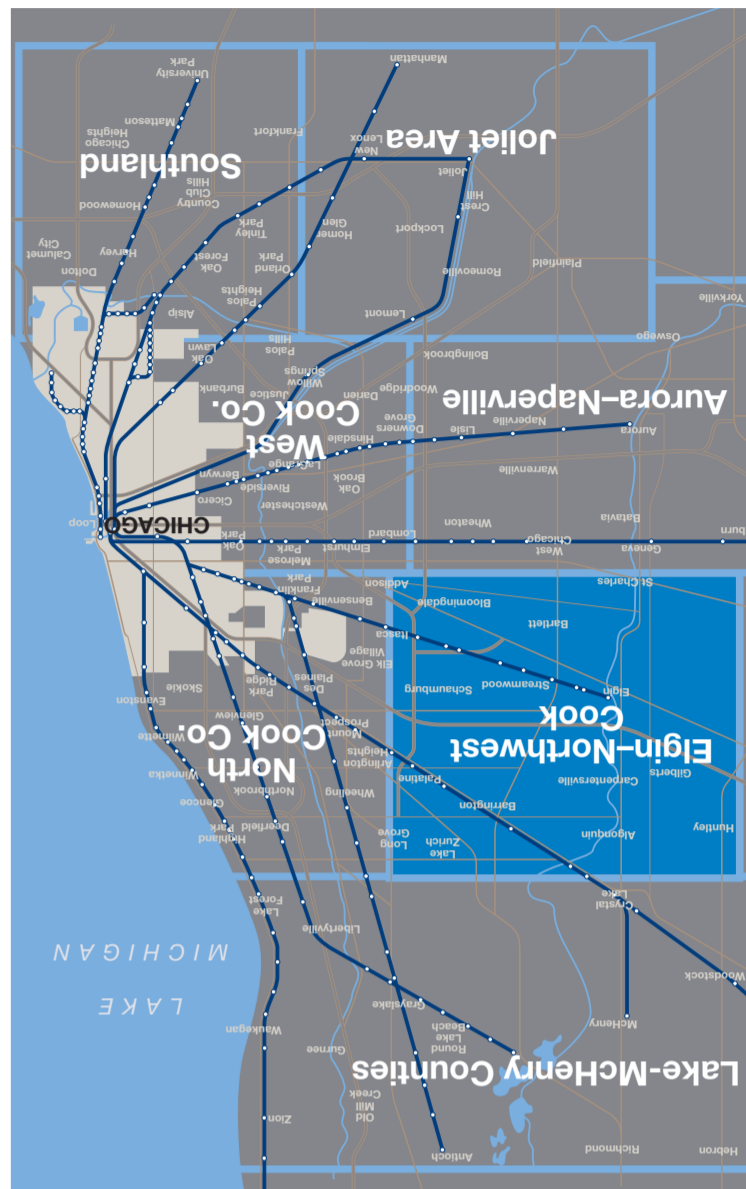

CTA and Pace Fares

Ventra™ is the region's fare payment system, which makes it faster and easier to board and pay. Ventra Transit Accounts can be loaded with value and passes using the Ventra App, cash, coins or bank cards at any Ventra vending machine, hundreds of Ventra retailers (payment types accepted may vary), or with credit/debit cards online and by phone.

Cash is accepted on buses. No transfers are issued when paying in cash.

Single-Ride Ventra Tickets cost \$3, provide up to 2 transfers within 2 hours and include a limited-use media fee. Buy new Ventra Cards or Tickets at any Ventra Vending Machine. A special \$5 fare applies when boarding the CTA Blue Line at O'Hare paying transit value or buying a Single-Ride "Ticket" (the special fare does not apply when using a pass to ride).

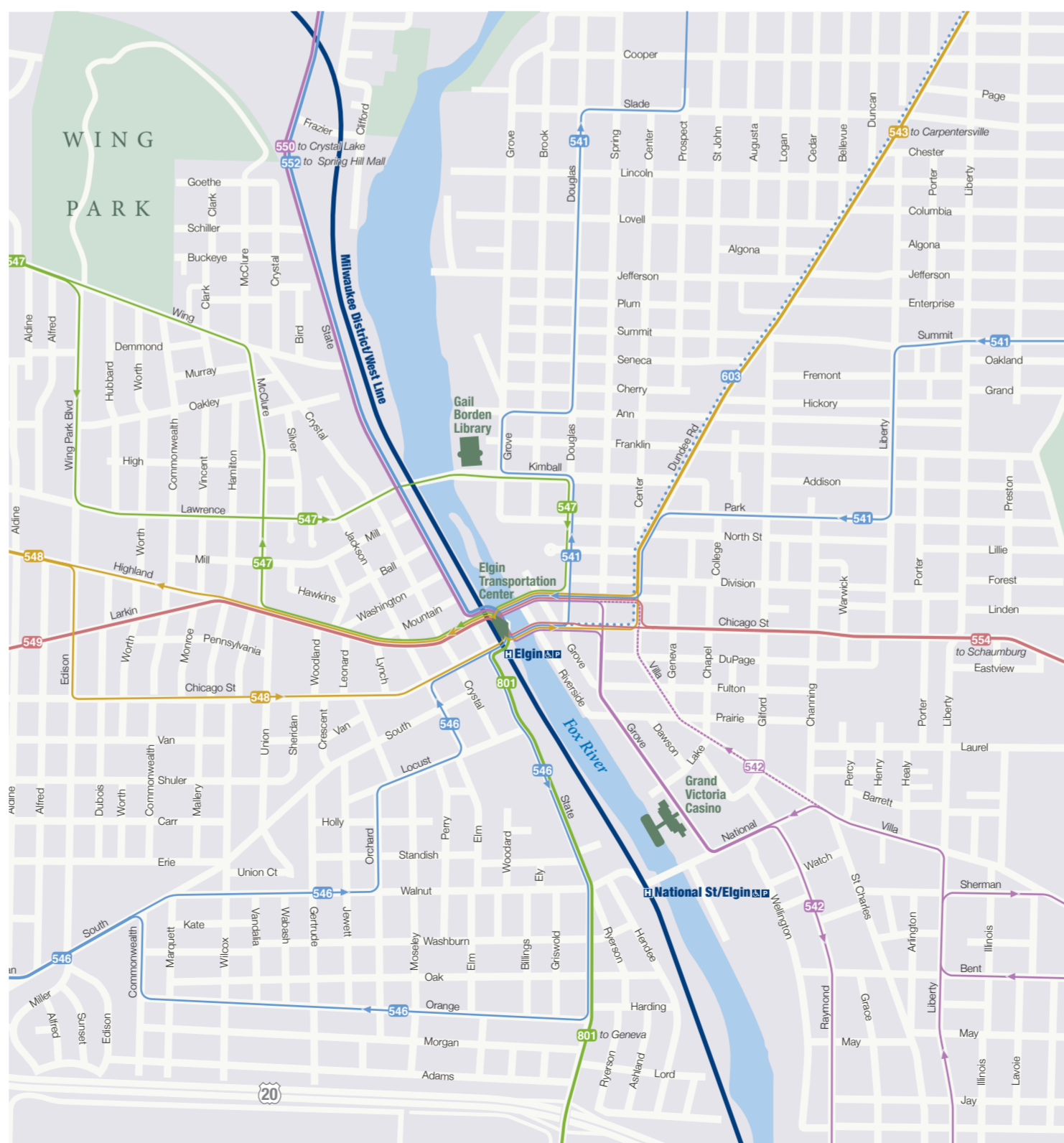

NICTD (South Shore Line) Fares

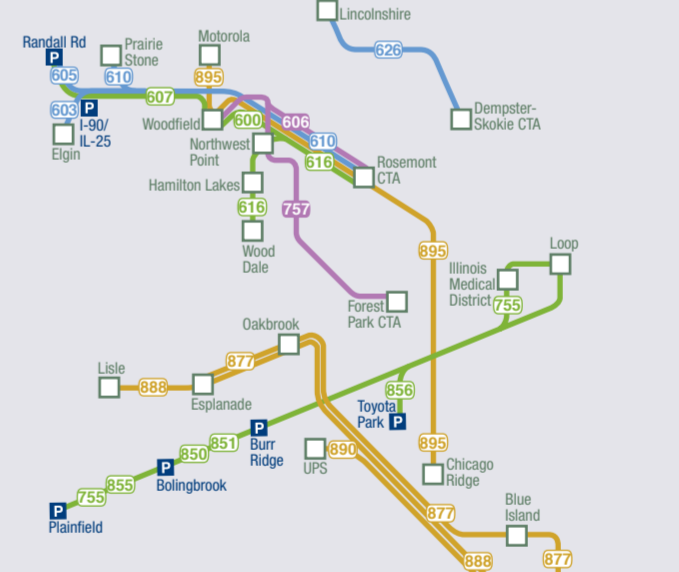
