The Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) provides financial oversight, funding, and regional transit planning for the three public transit operations in Northeastern Illinois that serve two million riders each weekday: The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA), Metra and Pace bus and paratransit. The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) runs bus and elevated/subway trains in Chicago and nearby suburbs. For current fare and schedule information, visit transitchicago.com

Pace moves people throughout the Chicago region with fixed bus routes, Dial-a-Ride, Call-n-Ride and other community transit programs. Most Pace bus routes connect with Metra and CTA service. For schedules and fares, visit PaceBus.com

CTA and Pace Fares

Ventra® is the region's fare payment system, which makes it faster and easier to board and pay. Ventra Transit Accounts can be loaded with value and passes using the Ventra App, cash, coins or bank cards at any Ventra vending machine, hundreds of Ventra retailers (payment types accepted may vary), or with credit/debit cards online and by phone.



Cash is accepted on buses. Fares can also be paid using a contactless bankcard or certain smartphones—but a full cash fare will be deducted for each ride. Transfers are not available.

All CTA and Pace buses are rampequipped and make automated stop announcements. 
