



54th YARD SPECIAL NOTES

- 1. The normal setting of the spring and stay switch on track 8 is for a move into track 8.
- 2. The blue add and cut lights in the westbound station pocket should be turned 'on' whenever adding or cutting takes place in that pocket.
- 3. The normal setting of the spring and stay switch on the loop track is for operation over the loop track.
- 4. Because the shop occasionally moves a train on tracks 7, 8, or 9 for test purposes, Switchmen operating on these tracks should check train clearances.
- 5. The direction sign is uncovered whenever the Yard Foreman wants to stop a train operating on the loop track in the reverse direction.
- 6. The track number markers are also train clearance markers.

RULE 227. SPEED IN YARDS

- (a) The speed of trains within Yard Limits must not exceed six (6) miles per hour.
- (b) Yard Foremen, Switchmen, and Motormen operating trains on any tracks within Yard Limits must use no more than one (1) point of power and be prepared to stop immediately.
