

Games at other times:

Service starts about 2 hours before the event from Chicago/Michigan, and the last bus starts 30 minutes before. Buses run every 12 minutes, making the stops shown above.

The #19 (a) also operates for special events. All #19 buses are accessible.


TO UNITED CENTER: (solid red on map)

Service begins about two hours before events, running every 12 minutes until about 30 minutes before the event. Board at stops southbound on Michigan, westbound on Madison. Connections are made with Metra trains at Randolph St. Station, Ogilvie Transportation Center, and Union Station.

You can also get to the United Center from downtown on the #20 Madison bus, which travels west on Madison starting at Wabash, and makes all stops along the way. The #20 & runs around-the-clock, every few minutes.

FROM UNITED CENTER (solid black on map):

Buses are waiting eastbound on Madison in front of the United Center. Service runs every few minutes until 30 minutes after events end. Buses make limited stops on Washington and ALL stops on Michigan.

Buy CTA Transit Cards and share them with up to 6 other riders at once. Full fares and transfers are deducted. Get cards at CTA rail stations or Currency Exchanges or Jewel or Dominick's food stores in the city and nearby suburbs. Recharge card at CTA rail stations. You can also buy Transit Cards and Passes in advance from the CTA's website at www.transitchicago.com



*Reduced fares are for children 7-11, and (with RTA ID) seniors 65 or older and riders with disabilities. Medicare Card holders are also eligible to apply for RTA Reduced Fare Program.

Ride to Medical Center Station on the Forest Park (Congress) branch. Use the exit/entrance at Damen. Walk two blocks north on Damen to the United Center. Trains run every 10 to 15 minutes. Board Downtown in the Dearborn Street subway. Free connections to other trains may be made at designated downtown stations. Look for "Forest Park" sign on train from Downtown.
