


X80 Irving Park Express

This crosstown connection serves Chicago's North and Northwest sides, with morning and afternoon rush period service between Harlem/Irving Park and the Lakefront, and **new midday and weekend service between the Lakefront and the Blue Line to O'Hare Airport.**

Whether it's a trip to work, the airport, shopping or entertainment, the X80 Irving Park Express  bus offers:

- faster service with fewer stops.
- express weekday bus service during morning and evening rush periods along Irving Park between the Lakefront and Harlem. Operates every 12 to 15 minutes.
- new midday express service between the Lakefront and the Irving Park Blue Line station, for a convenient connection to O'Hare Airport. Operates every 12 minutes.
- new weekend express service scheduled around peak travel hours at O'Hare Airport. Service operates Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, every 12 minutes.
- direct bus connections to CTA's Blue, Brown and Red lines, as well as Metra's Irving Park station.

Transit Cards — Deduct full fares and transfers on CTA and Pace (except Pace Route 835). Full-fare Transit Cards can be purchased from vending machines at CTA rail stations. Put in the exact amount you want on the card (\$1.75 to \$100). Up to seven full-fare customers can share a Transit Card.

The Chicago Card and Chicago Card Plus are the faster, easier ways to pay your fare. Enjoy quick touch-and-go boarding on CTA buses and trains and Pace buses (except Pace Route 835).

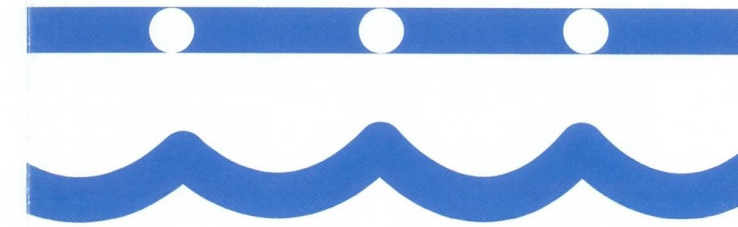

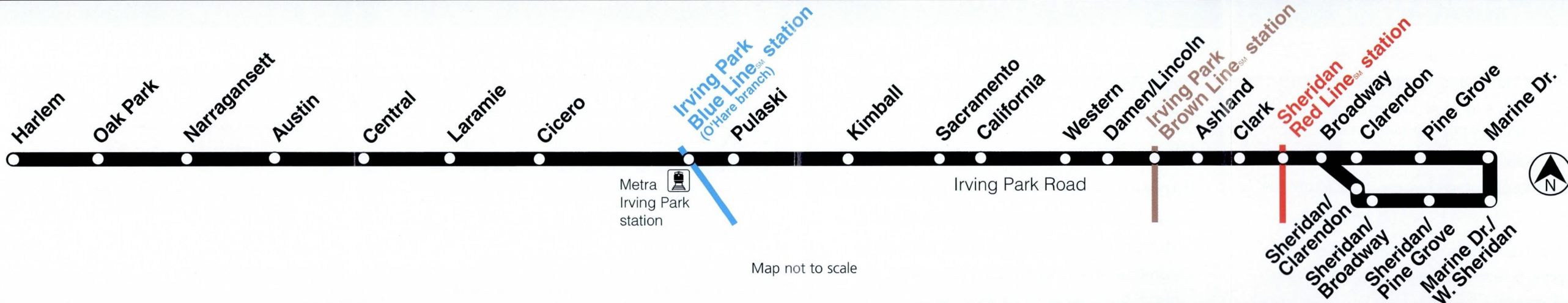
