FARES & TRANSFERS

- 50¢ Adults
- 60¢ Adults purchasing RTA transfer.

- 30¢ Adults showing monthly railroad ticket, going to or from Railroad Station.
- 60¢ Adults with Railroad ticket purchasing RTA transfer.

- 25¢ Grade & High School students (with NORTAN card).
- 30¢ Grade & High School students purchasing RTA transfer.

- 25¢ Senior Citizens and Handicapped (with RTA card).
- 30¢ Senior Citizens and Handicapped purchasing RTA transfer.

The RTA Transfer

RTA transfers are valid until the time punched on them (usually two to four hours). Until that time you can ride in any direction, from route to route and from RTA System to RTA System.

You need an RTA transfer to go from a LOCAL to a SUBURBAN ROUTE, or vice versa. They are accepted on CTA buses and trains, and on WILBUS, WEST TOWNS, and other RTA routes. COMMUTER RAIL LINES (C&NW or Milwaukee Rd.) do not accept them.

CTA Transfer

If your trip starts in Chicago, you may use your CTA transfer—which is valid for three hours from the time punched—to ride a NORTAN or RTA bus.

Reduced Sunday Fares

- 30¢ ADULT (RTA Transfer 10¢) 60¢ to Loop
- 15¢ SENIOR CITIZEN, HANDICAPPED (RTA Transfer 5¢) 30¢ to Loop

Sunday Supertransfer

Ride all day, in any direction, across any zones—anywhere on any NORTAN, CTA, or RTA bus, and CTA RAPID TRANSIT.

- 80¢* ADULT, STUDENT
 - 50¢* SENIOR CITIZEN, HANDICAPPED
- *includes basic fare plus cost of transfer
