

Reduced Fares are available for children (ages 7-11), students traveling to and from school, and persons with disabilities. The RTA Reduced Fare Permit is required for persons with disabilities. Free rides are offered to area residents age 65 and older (with a Senior Reduced Fare Card or Senior Ride Free Smart Card), children under 7, and active duty military personnel in uniform. Persons with disabilities (who are enrolled in the Illinois Circuit Breaker Program) may ride Pace fixed route service free of charge with the Circuit Permit.
