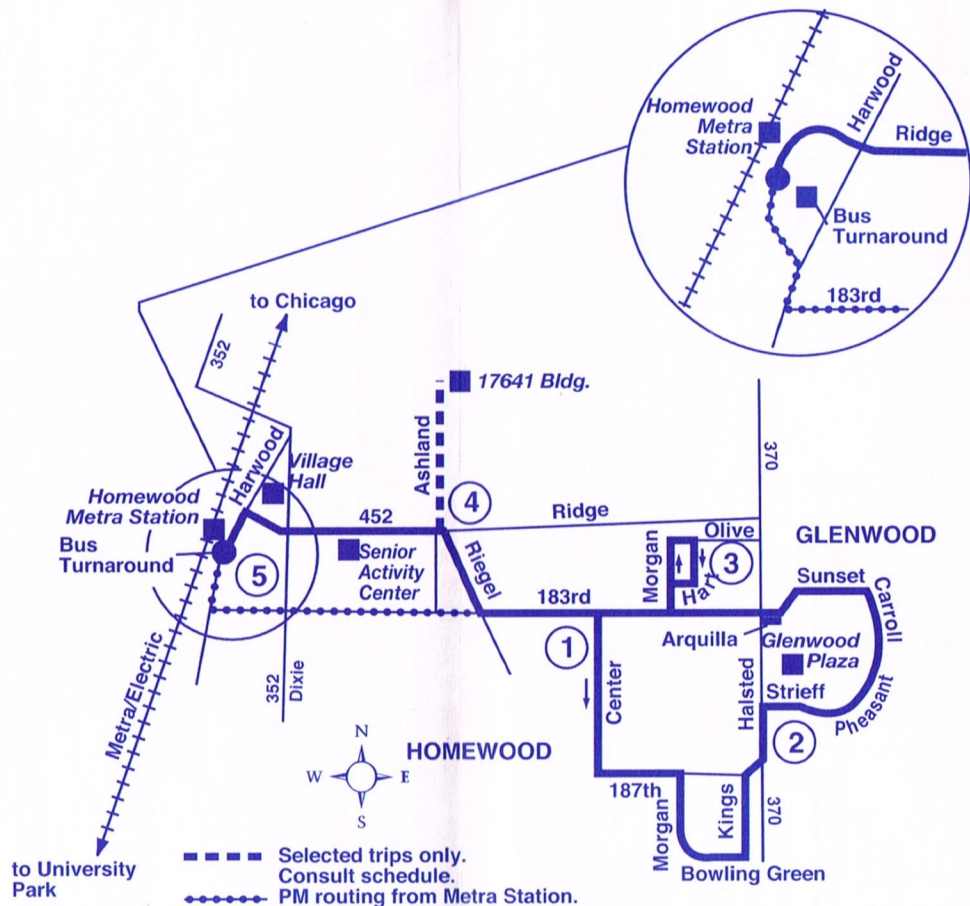

The RTA Reduced Fare Permit is required for seniors and persons with disabilities. A Medicare Card and another source of identification with a photograph and a date of birth are acceptable to obtain the Permit.
