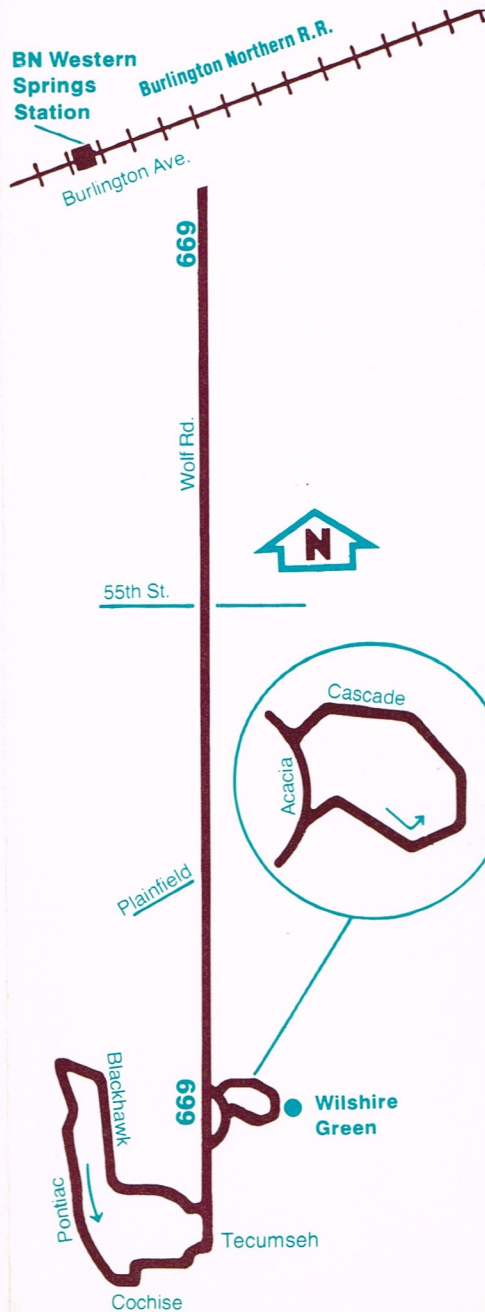


The R.T.A Transfer

—Economical
—Convenient—

After you get off your Burlington Northern train, do you ride another R.T.A. bus or 'L' Route? (Remember, C.T.A. is also an R.T.A. service.) If you do, buy an R.T.A. Universal Transfer when you board your Western Springs bus. The transfer is good on other R.T.A. bus and 'L' routes in Chicago and suburbs even if you've ridden the BN in between

Returning, your R.T.A. or C.T.A. transfer will be good on the Western Springs Bus. You'll save money, and you won't need to carry as much change. Regular adult bus fare including the transfer is just 60¢
