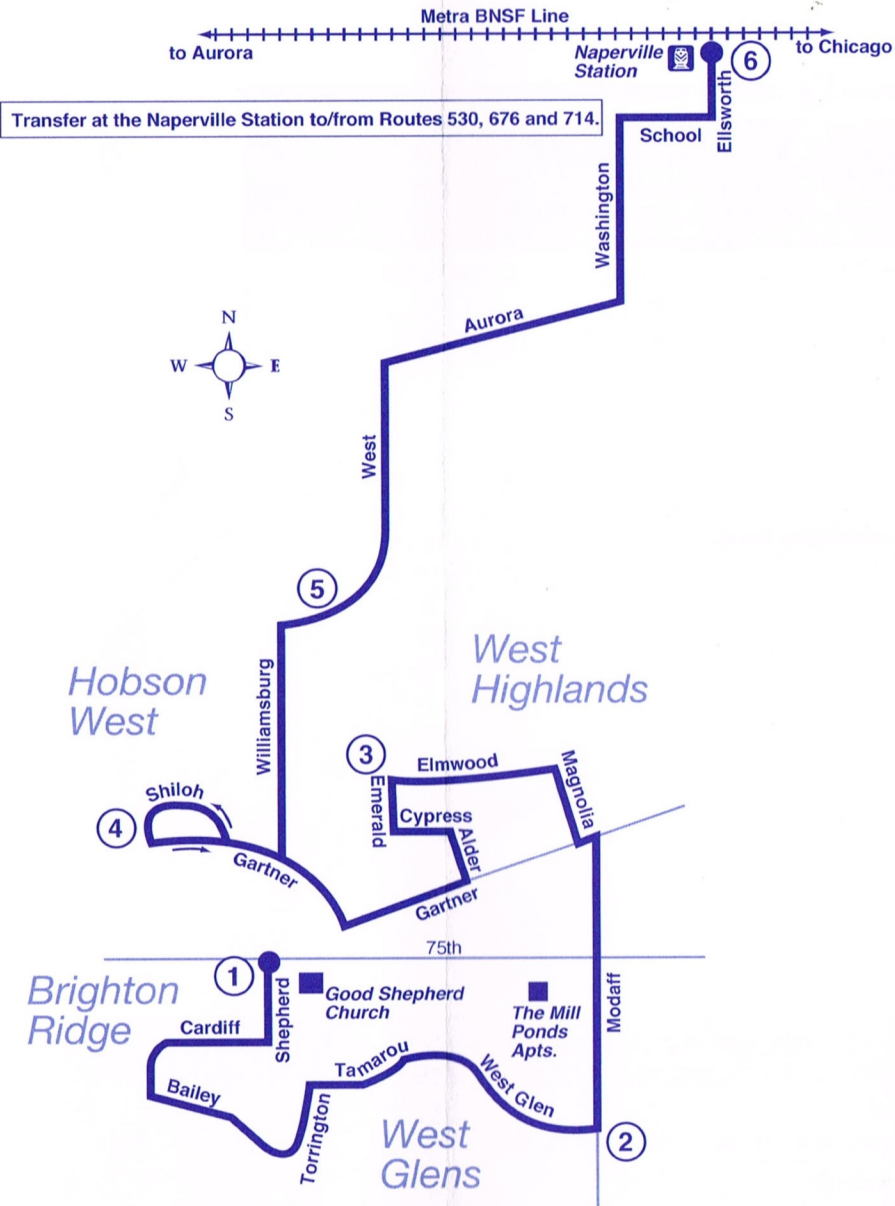

## REGULAR FARE ROUTE

Pace has a variety of passes and tickets that can make traveling on Pace, CTA and Metra easier and more cost effective. Call (847) 364-7223 or visit [www.pacebus.com](http://www.pacebus.com) for details. Reduced Fares are available for children (ages 7-11), students traveling to and from school, persons with disabilities and seniors. The RTA Reduced Fare Permit is required for persons with disabilities and seniors. A Medicare card along with another source of identification with a photograph and date of birth is acceptable to obtain the RTA Reduced Fare Card/Permit. Free rides are offered to children under 7 (max two children per fare paying adult), law enforcement officers and firefighters in full uniform or presenting a badge, and active duty military personnel in uniform. Persons with disabilities and residents aged 65 and older who are enrolled in the Illinois Circuit Breaker Program may ride Pace fixed route service free of charge with the Circuit Ride Free card.
