Due to constantly changing expressway traffic conditions on I-290 and I-90, bus may arrive ahead of or behind schedule.

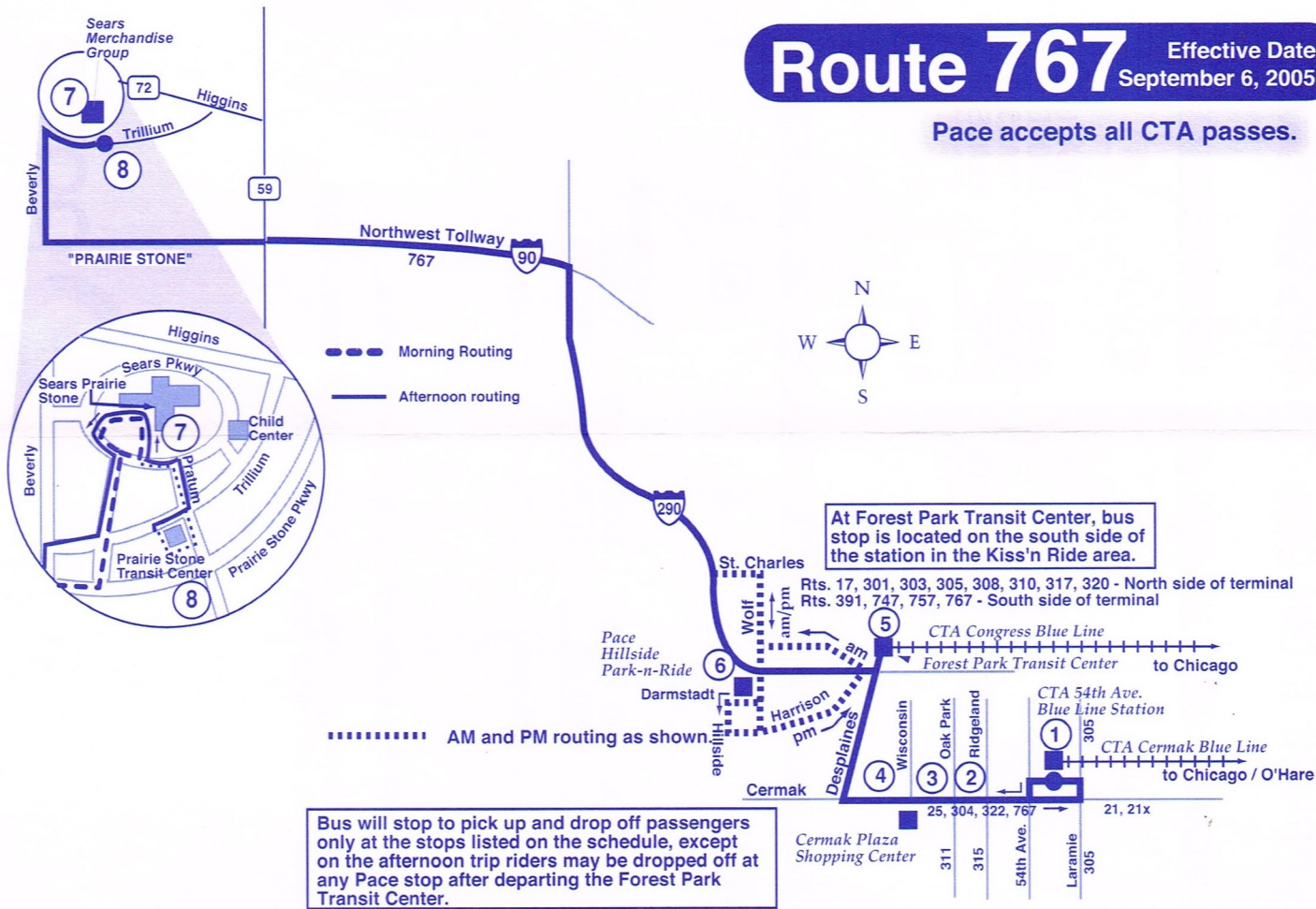
