CONDITIONS GOVERNING TICKETS

The following conditions apply to fares between stations of the Norfolk and Western and Bus Route 835.

ONE-WAY TICKETS are on sale, limit of six months including date of sale. Tickets are not good for passage of more than one person per trip.

WEEKLY TICKETS (Sold by Ticket Agent)

Ticket is valid for unlimited rides, for the week issued. Good only for the exclusive use of the person named on back of the ticket, between limits of the zones as shown on the face of the ticket. Tickets will be on sale beginning Thursday of the preceding week.

MONTHLY TICKETS (Sold by Ticket Agent)

Valid for unlimited rides, for the calendar month issued. Good only for exclusive use of the person named on the back of the ticket, between limits of the zones as shown on the face of the ticket. Tickets will be honored until noon of the first business day of the succeeding month. Tickets will be on sale the 23rd day of the preceding month.

ELDERLY/HANDICAPPED TICKETS (Sold only to persons upon presentation of a valid RTA Senior Citizen or Handicapped Identification Card)

RTA Identification Cards must be shown when the reduced fare ticket is purchased and when presented for passage on trains. The carrier is not responsible for issuance of the RTA Identification Card or determining qualification for the issuance of such cards.

STUDENT TICKETS

Sold only to full-time students of high school age and below, traveling to and from school, presenting a certificate from an accredited school of learning -- grades K through 12, attesting that the student is in regular attendance. Ticket is not valid on Saturday, Sunday or Holidays.

CHILDREN TICKETS

Children ages seven (7) through eleven (11) will pay one-half the one-way fare or less, rounded down to the nearest nickel. Children under age seven (7), when accompanied by an adult fare paying passenger with a maximum of three (3) such free fare children per adult fare paying passenger, shall be transported free.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

Elderly/Handicapped and Student tickets are GOOD ONLY FOR THE PERSONAL USE OF THE TICKET PURCHASER. Monthly and Weekly tickets are GOOD ONLY FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE PERSON NAMED ON THE BACK OF THE TICKET. If presented by any other person, the ticket will be confiscated by the Conductor or Driver.

GENERAL INFORMATION

No Refunds will be made or replacement tickets issued for lost, destroyed or stolen tickets.

The Conductor or Driver is required to collect published one-way fare from passengers not presenting Monthly or Weekly, and such fare is not reimbursible.

Tickets should be purchased before boarding the train. If the ticket office is open at the train departure time, conductors are required to charge additionally when collecting one-way cash fares on the train.

The schedules, fares and other arrangements shown in the timetable are subject to change without notice. Neither carrier nor RTA assumes any responsibility for errors in the timetable, for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed or cancelled trains. No checked baggage, bicycles, dogs or other pets will be carried on trains. Seeing-eye or guide dogs assisting blind persons are permitted on trains and buses.

No stopovers permitted.

Refunds where applicable can be made only to persons whose name appears on the back of the ticket. Applications for refunds on Weekly and Monthly tickets should be made by the U.S. Mail to:

Postmark on envelope determines the last date of use. Weekly and Monthly refunds are computed by charging the lowest combinations of fares applicable between the same points for each day the ticket is not in the carrier's possession up to and including the postmark date (excluding Saturday, Sunday and Holidays). Wholly unused one-way tickets will be redeemed by refunding fare paid for such tickets at any ticket office.

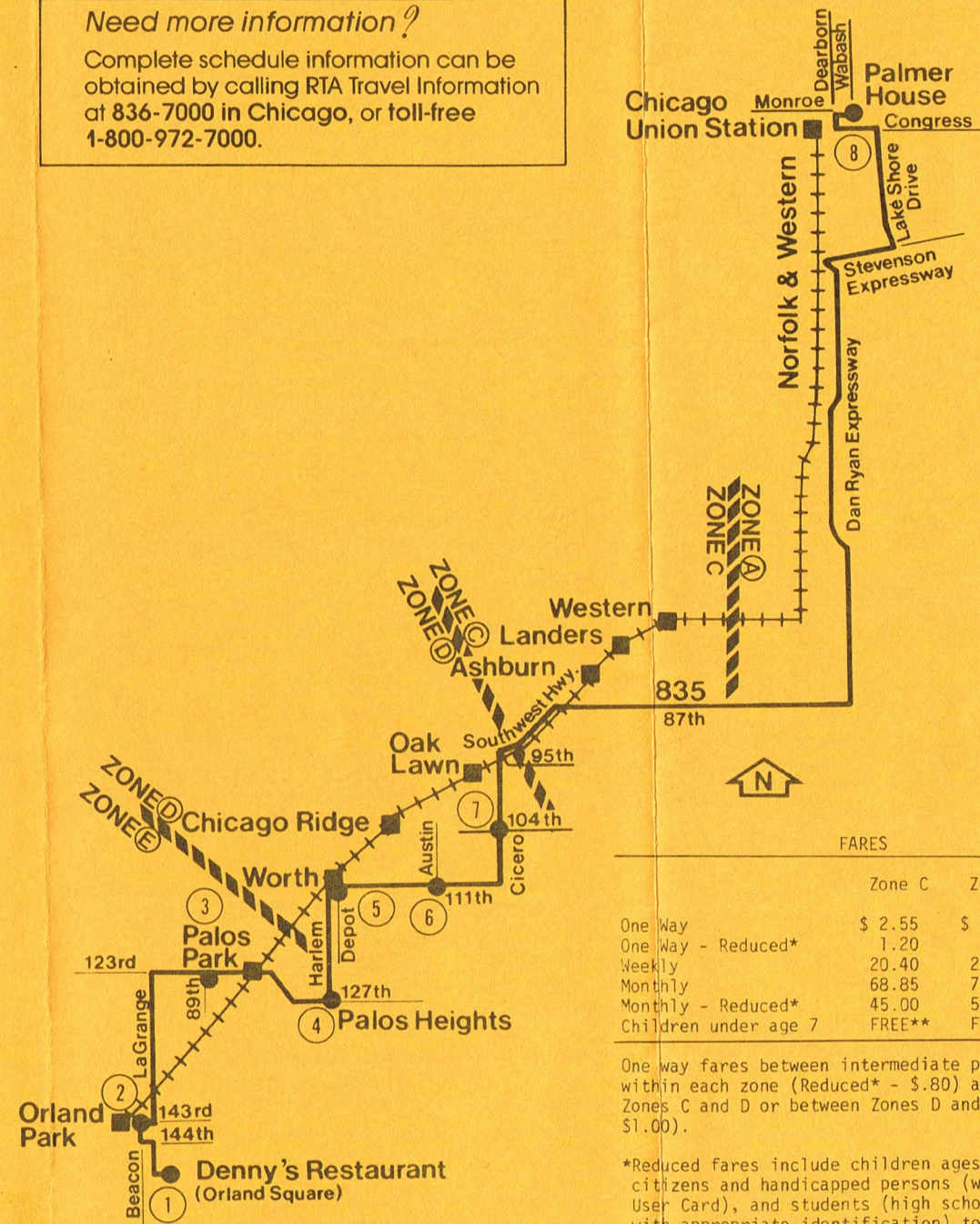

*Reduced fares include children ages 7-11, senior citizens and handicapped persons (with RTA Special User Card), and students (high school age or younger with appropriate identification) to or from school only, during school hours.

**When accompanied by a fare paying passenger (a maximum of two children for each fare paying passenger).
