

Pace has a variety of passes and tickets that can make traveling on Pace, CTA and Metra easier and more cost effective, Call (847) 364-7223 or visit www.pacebus.com for details. Reduced Fares are available for children (ages 7-11), students traveling to and from school, persons with disabilities and seniors. The RTA Reduced Fare Permit is required for persons with disabilities and seniors. A Medicare card along with another source of identification with a photograph and date of birth is acceptable to obtain the RTA Reduced Fare Card/Permit. Free rides are offered to children under 7 (max two children per fare paying adult), law enforcement officers and firefighters in full uniform or presenting a badge, and active duty military personnel in uniform. Persons with disabilities and residents aged 65 and older who are enrolled in the Illinois Circuit Breaker Program may ride Pace fixed route service free of charge with the Circuit Ride Free card. 

* At the Pace Northwest Transportation Center, please tell the driver at which stop along the Schaumburg route segment you want to be dropped off. Routing on the Schaumburg route segment for northbound trips will vary (or flex) based on passenger destinations. The operator may bypass certain stops if no one wishes to alight there, but will not serve locations that are not along the established routing. Buses will drop off passengers upon request to the driver at any intersection along the Schaumburg route segment where it is safe to do so.

- Bus stops at Chicago Ridge Mall are located on 95th Street at the main mall entrance.

PS Posted Stops Only (Partial)

Buses will stop at Posted Stops Only as follows:

- On all trips on the route's express segment between Chicago Ridge Mall, CTA Blue Line Rosemont Station and Pace Northwest Transportation Center.
- . On southbound trips (midday and evening) on the route's local segment in Schaumburg, passengers may board only at bus stop signs with the Pace logo and route number. Please wait for the bus at a bus stop sign.

Note: Due to constantly changing traffic conditions on the Tri-State, Reagan, Veterans and Jane Addams Tollways, trips may run ahead of or behind schedule.
