

THE R.T.A. TRANSFER Economical Convenient

After you get off your North Western train, do you ride another RTA bus or 'L' route? (Remember, CTA is also an RTA service.) If you do, buy an RTA Universal Transfer when you board your Lombard bus. The transfer is good on other RTA bus and 'L' routes, in Chicago and suburbs, even if you've ridden the North Western in between. The RTA or CTA transfer you buy when returning will be good on the Lombard bus. You'll save money, and you won't need to carry as much change. Regular adult bus fare, including the Transfer, is just 60¢.

RTA Travel Information is a 24 hour facility. For better service, call during the off-peak hours.
