# How to read this timetable







- 1 Locate the timepoint on the map nearest to the point you will be boarding the bus. Timepoints are indicated by this symbol 
- 2 Refer to the line with the same timepoint number in the timetable, for the direction you want to be heading, to determine what time buses pass that location.
- 3 Estimate how long it will take the bus to get between the timepoint and the place you will be boarding. The light dashed lines (---) are placed at approximately five minute intervals on the map.

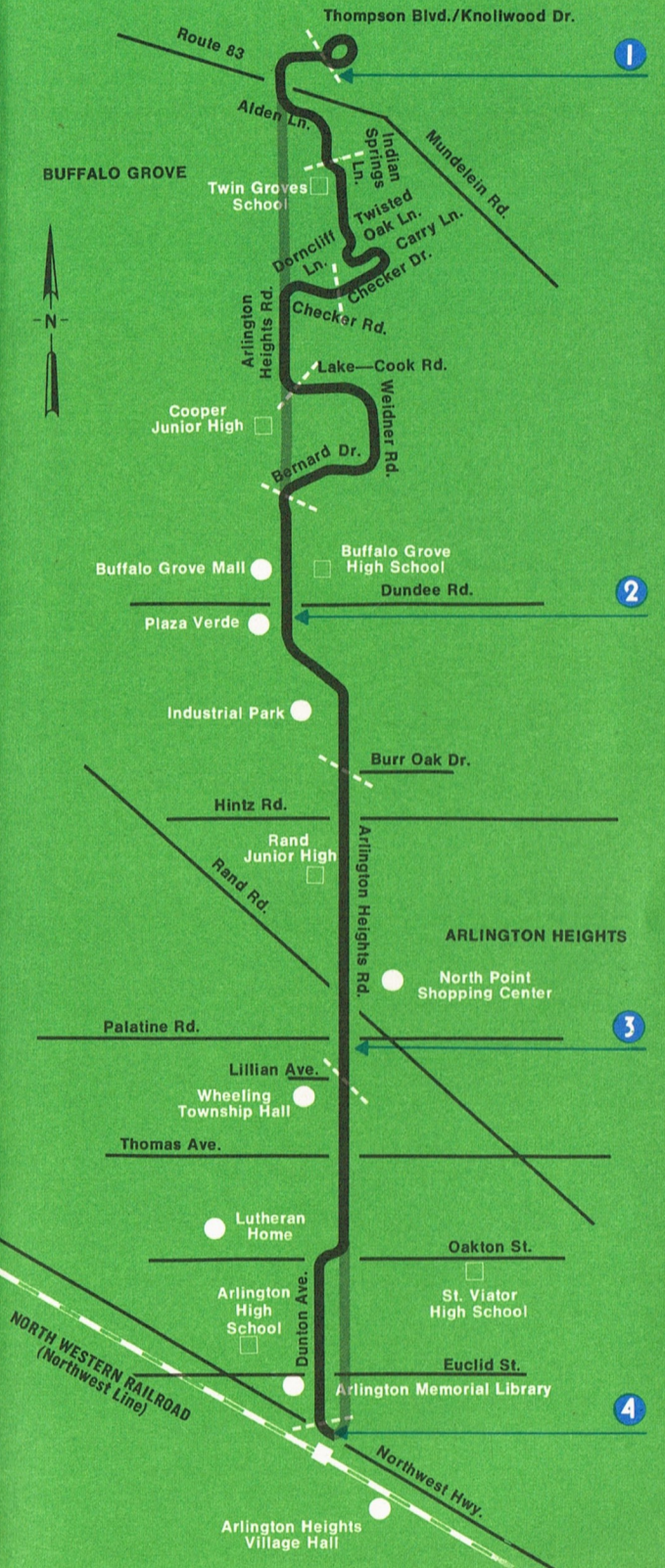
Train times at North Western Arlington Heights/station and at the Chicago/North Western station are shown in dark blue.

Buses will stop at any point on signal except on Arlington Heights Road where they will stop only at intersections.

It is a good idea when you start to use the bus to be at your boarding point a few minutes earlier than the time you have estimated for the bus' arrival.

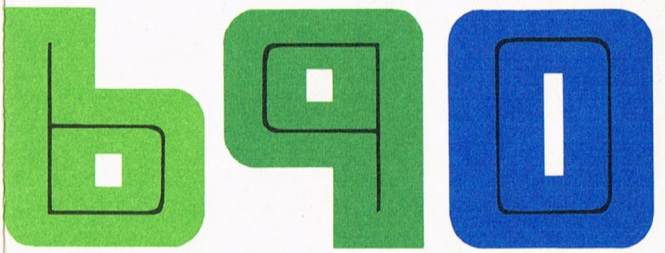
